Project Description Summary

Florence County would like to rehab a 5100' section of trail C6 in the Town of Commonwealth starting south of Massies Landing (45.8320136,-88.2282342) and ending at Krans' Corner (45.8204165,-88.2204477). This trail is a dual use, year round accessible corridor trail and the only means of accessing the Town of Florence from the southern portion of the county. Corridor 2 traveling east and west from the state of Michigan provides the only other option. We have estimated the use of 360 yards of crushed ore for base restoration (where needed) and 1340 yards of 6" thick gravel to cap the trail surface. Over the past several years, this corridor has experienced a great deal of abuse and with the most recent surge in new users since the pandemic, this area will continue to degrade. There is no gravel left to maintain a smooth groomed trail surface and the original trail bed is all that remains. There are several eroded areas and large water holes with 12-16 inches of standing water in them. We are going to raise the low areas with crushed ore, install ditches, and runoffs (where needed) to keep the water off the trail. We are asking for 80% (\$31677.19) funding from the ATV-UTV Program and the remaining 20% (\$7919.30) from the Snowmobile Program as this does provide a benefit to this dual use trail.

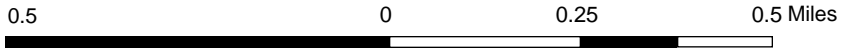




S.W.D.V. Map: Aerial, Wetland, Topo.
