Project Description Summary

Jackson County Forestry and Parks proposes to replace the deck on Crawford Bridge. This bridge was built in 2004 it is 12 wide and 80 feet long the deck is wood and setting on top of I beams. The deck boards are 3 inches thick by 12 inches wide and 12 feet long with 2 x 10 wear boards on both sides. The center of the deck is showing wear from snowmobiles and last fall when repairing the wear boards there was rot in the decking underneath them. We would be replacing all of the deck boards and wear boards, the railing looks to be in good shape.

This trail is open to ATV's year round, UTV's in the summer and snowmobiles in the winter.

Remove the wooden deck and replace it with a new wood deck. The railings are still in good shape and should not need replacing. The deck boards are 3 inches thick 12 inches wide and 12 feet long, there are 2 x 10 wear boards on both sides. The middle is showing wear and when we replaced a few wear boards last fall the deck was rotten underneath them.

There is no plans to change the main structure of the bridge it appears to be sound.

Depending on time and work load we may do the decking our selfs or contract it out, that has not been determined.

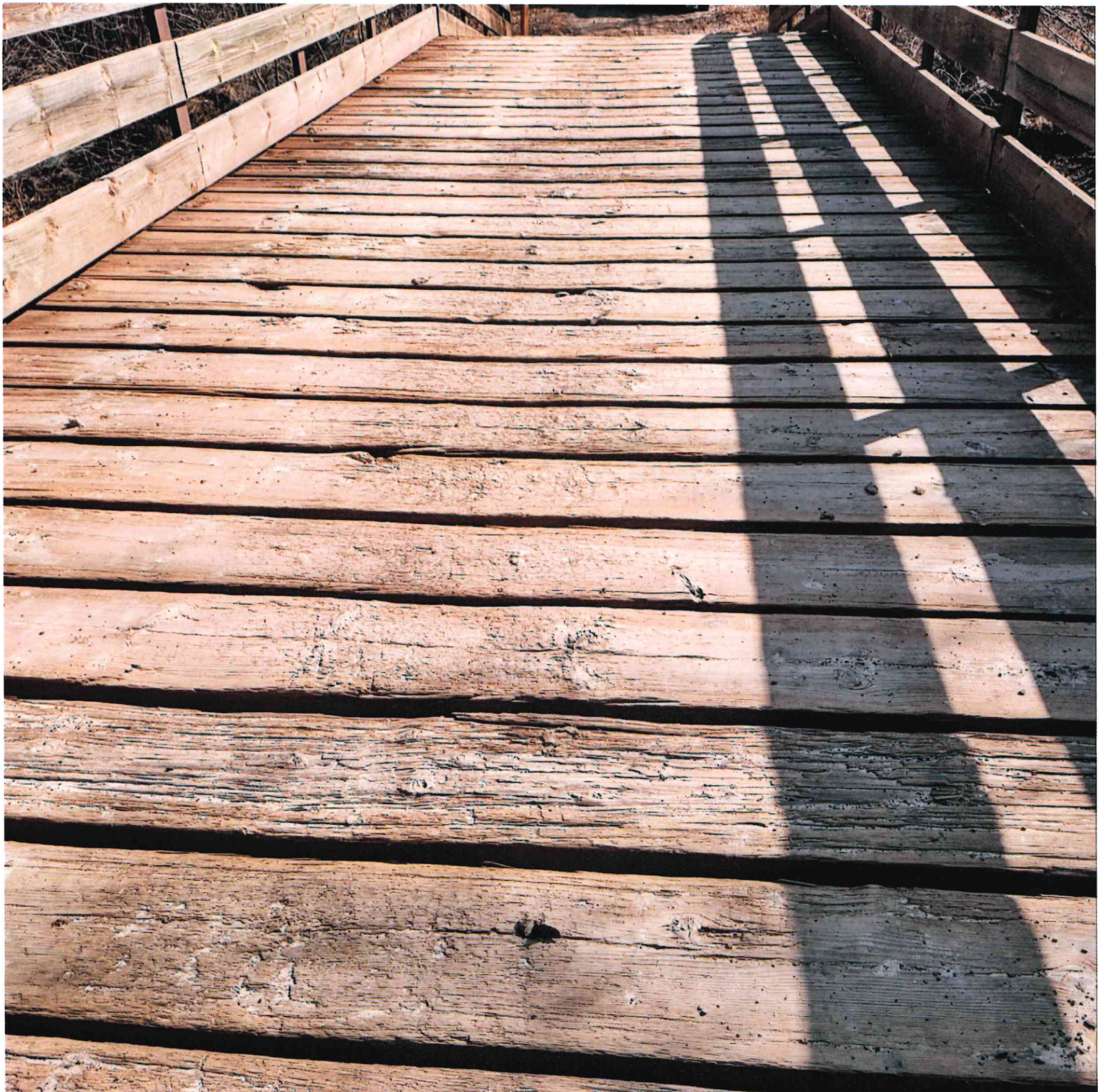

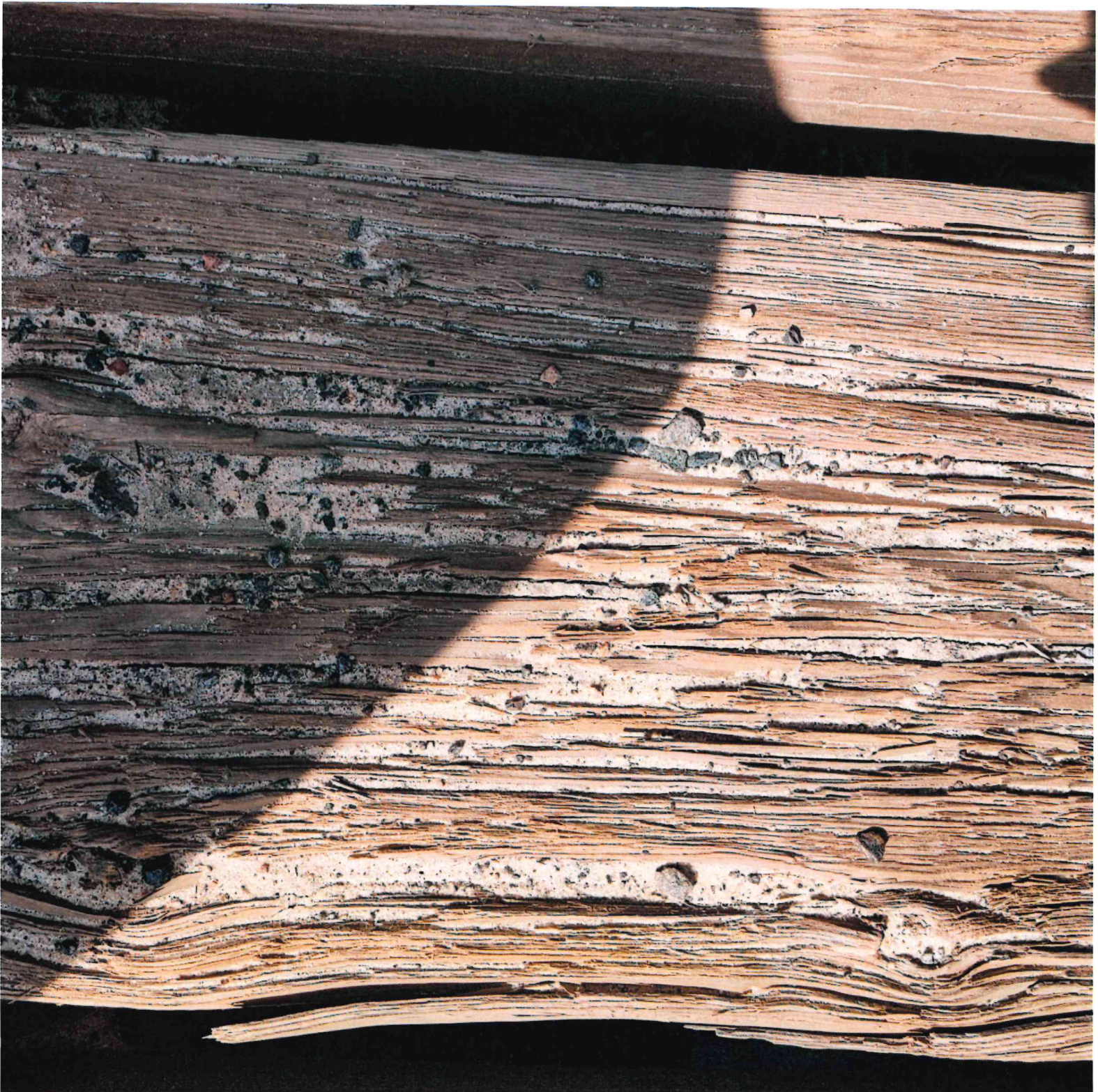

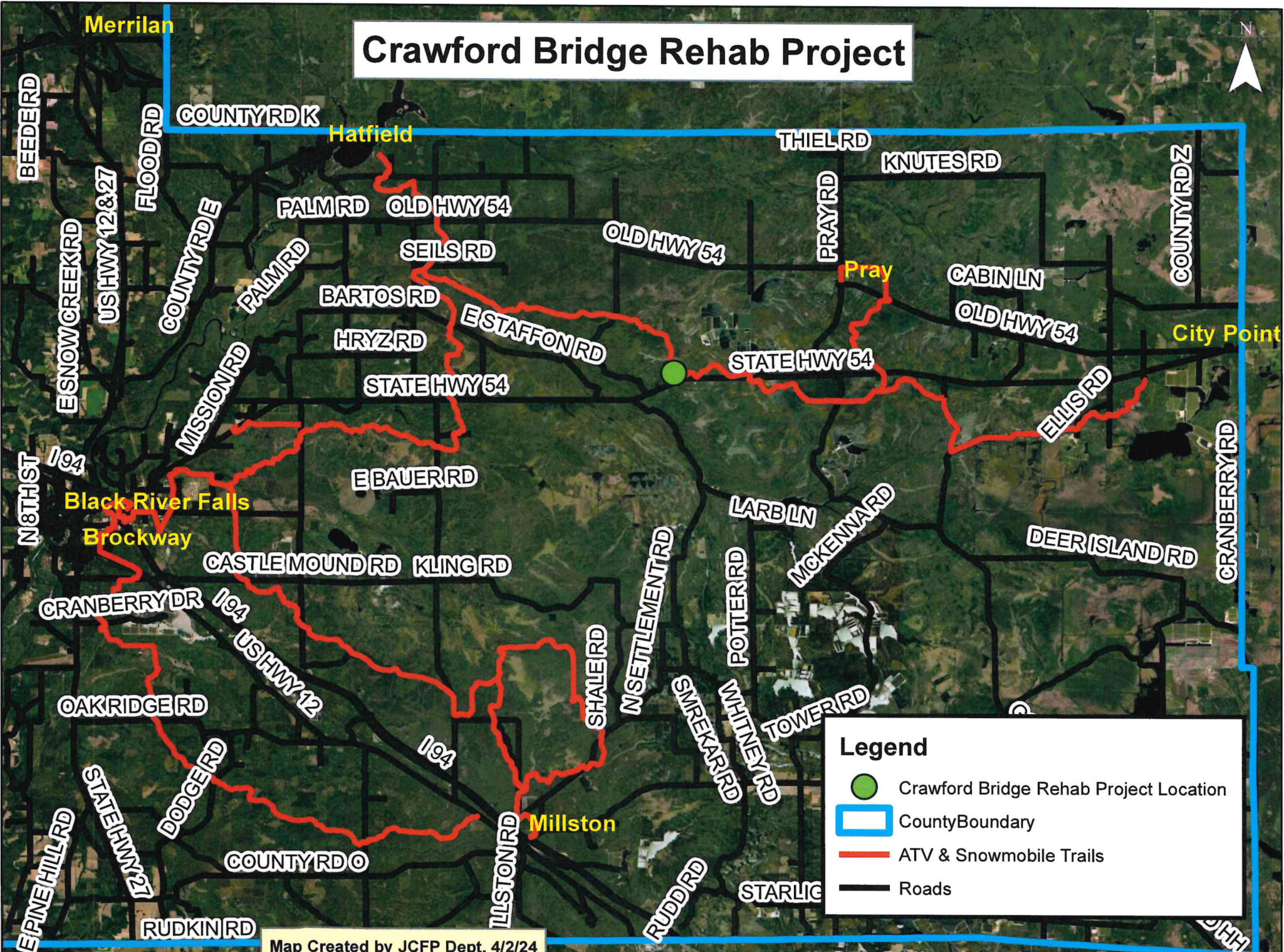












Crawford Bridge Rehab Project



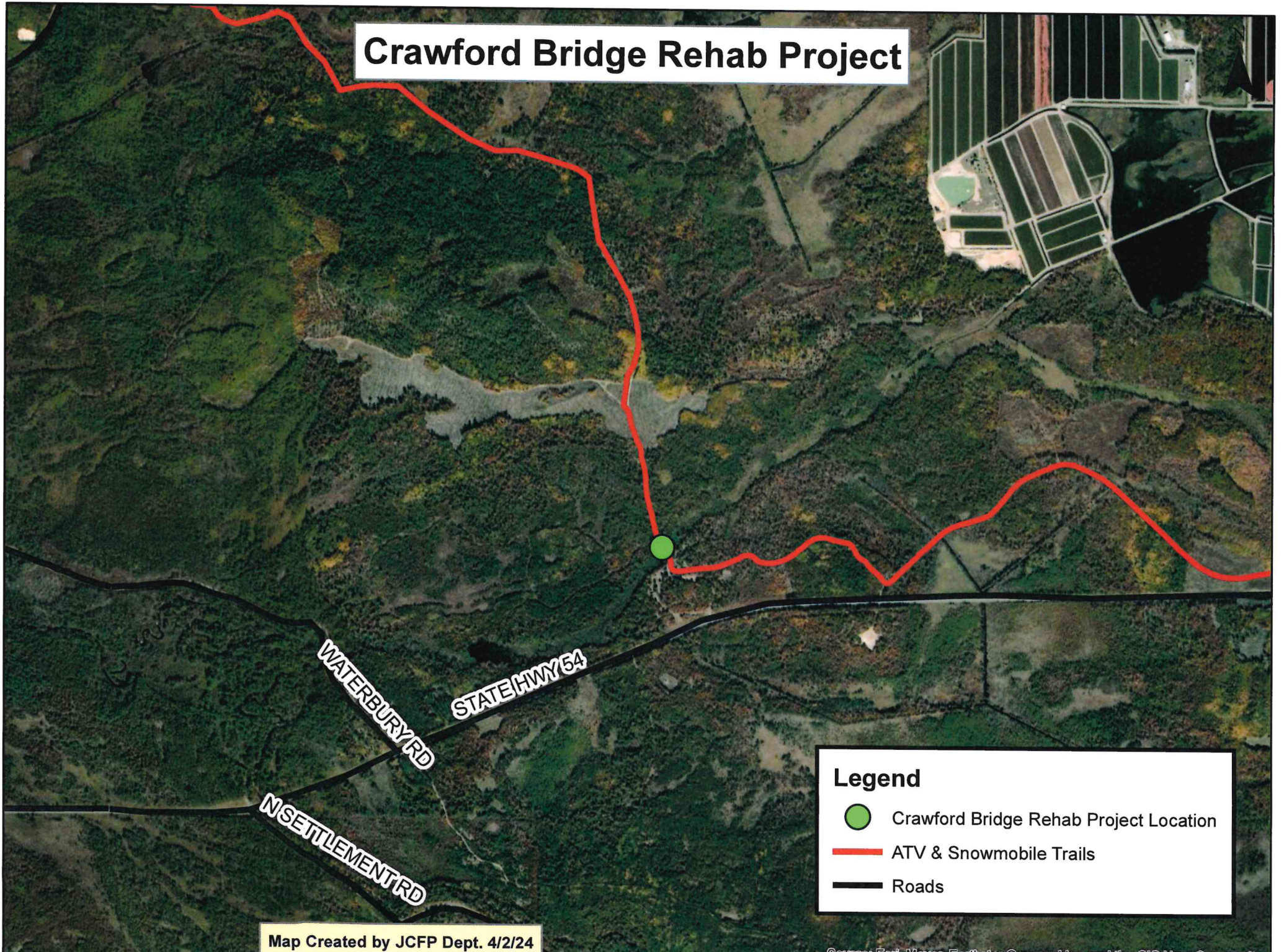

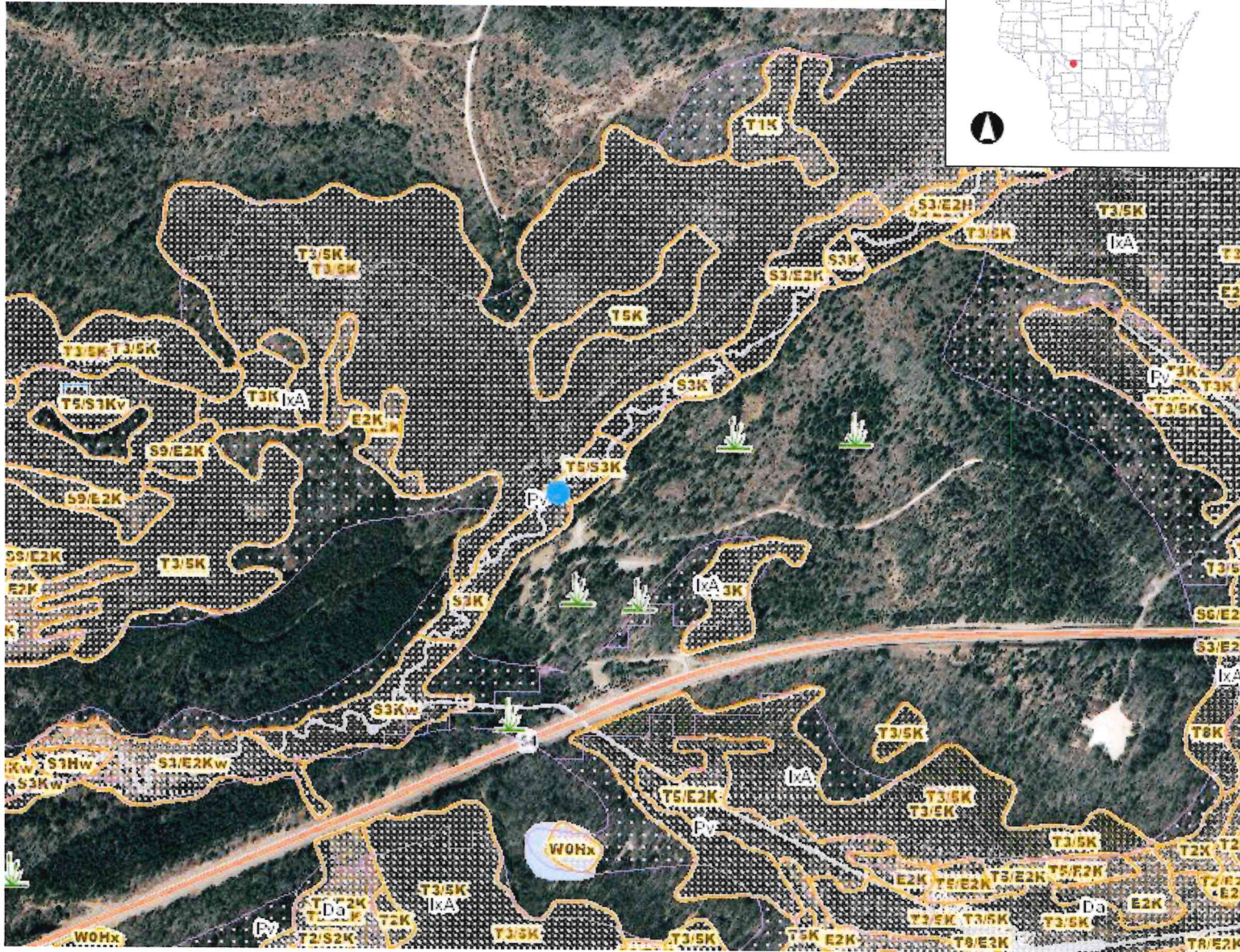

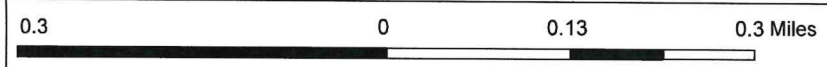

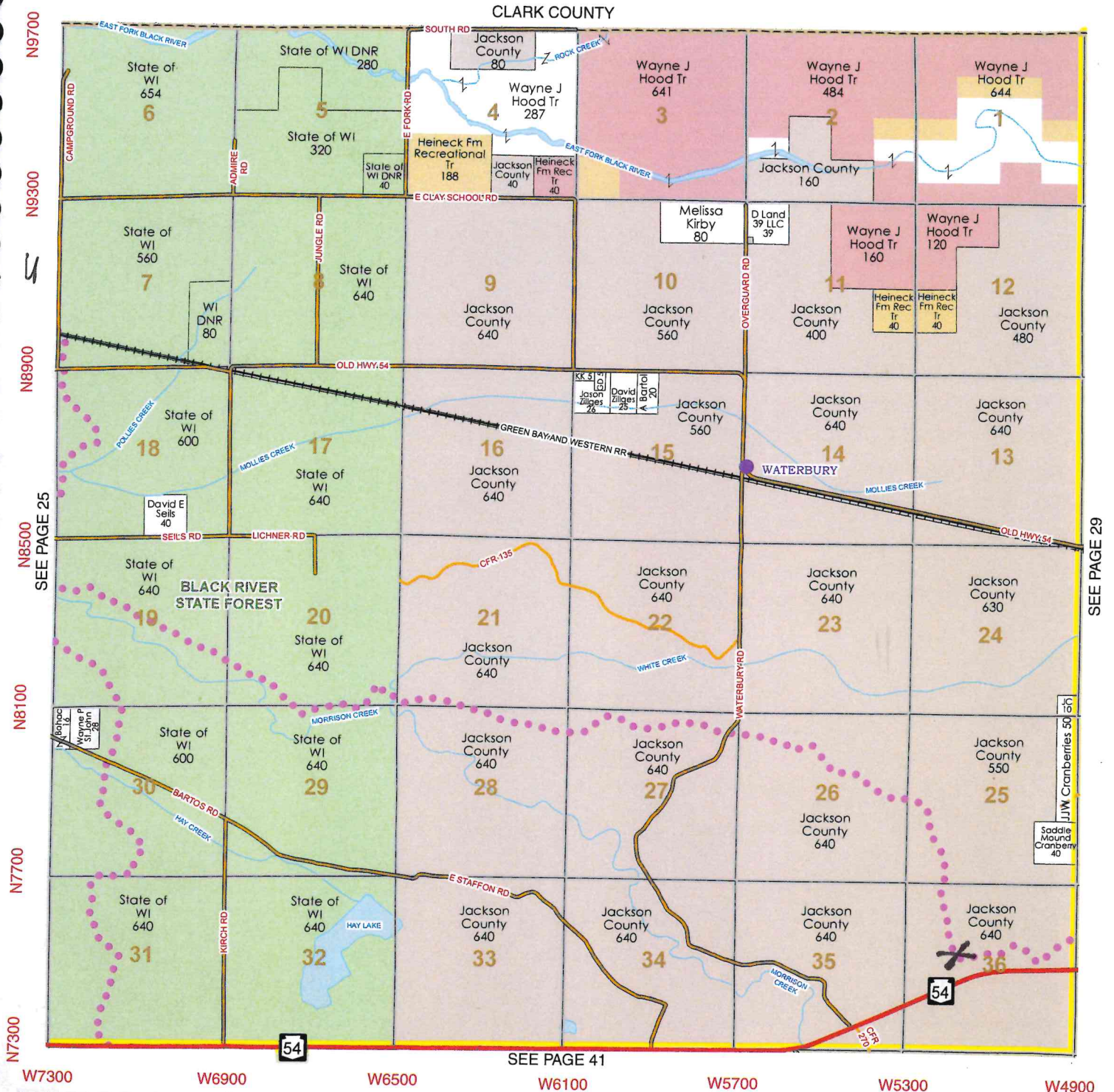
