Description of new trail: reconnection of the Corridor 7 trail between Waukesha County and Washington County. This corridor trail was lost due to a Land Owner change 10 years ago. The Land Manager has changed and has allowed for the reconnection of the trail. The Club has contacted all of the Land Owners the trail crosses for their permission to use their land for the snowmobile trail. The grading work, brushing and signing with reflective signs has been completed. This trail was open as a Club trail this past season. The trail will be groomed with Class AAA - 3 grooming equipment.
