- 1) This trail serves as a connection to Corridor 6 in Florence County and heads to Marinette County and travels S. into the Town of Dunbar.

- 3) This trail sees a high volume of traffic due to the availability of gas, food and lodging in the Town of Dunbar located in Marinette County.







Combination Snowmobile, ATV and UTV Trails


