

**Public Notice of  
Proposed Best Available Retrofit Technology (BART) Determination  
For Georgia-Pacific Consumer Products, L.P., Green Bay, WI  
for Visibility Protection**

**Background**

In response to federal clean air regulations requiring states to develop plans to address the impairment of visibility in certain pristine federal areas (Class I areas), the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) developed an administrative rule (ch. NR 433, Wis. Adm. Code). The rule requires certain categories of major stationary sources to install Best Available Retrofit Technology (BART) for visibility protection. The Georgia-Pacific Consumer Products, L.P. (Georgia Pacific) facility at 1919 S. Broadway, Green Bay, Brown County, Wisconsin, FID 405032870, was identified as a facility that was subject to BART requirements. Georgia Pacific submitted to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) a best available retrofit technology (BART) analysis to identify available control technologies for their units that are subject to BART. After reviewing the BART analysis submitted by Georgia Pacific along with other available information DNR has made a preliminary determination of the proposed BART requirements for Georgia Pacific. The proposed BART requirements are incorporated into a draft revision of Air Pollution Control Permit No. 405032870-P03.


