

RFQ Questions and Answers - RFQ# 25-488-41

1. Is WDNR intent for the respondent to provide a detailed project approach? No, but the respondent must provide *qualifications* that are *related* to this specific project, per Section 5.2. An approach to this specific project may be requested in the future Request for Proposal (RFP) .
2. After the RFQ is awarded, would a detailed SOW be provided, or would you be looking for support to develop a detailed SOW to aid in the procurement process? Per Section 2.1, “A more detailed scope of work (SOW) will be provided in the RFP.” DNR will not request assistance in development of the RFP.
