DNR updates

The DNR is working with the 2024 RR Program Rule Advisory Committee to draft two sets of
rule revisions. The first relates to continuing obligations, the second relates to soil
standards. Meetings of the Rule Advisory Committee are open to the public. The next
meeting of the Rule Advisory Committee will be April 12, 2024, and meeting information and
registration is available on DNR's NR 700 rule changes web page (go to dnr.wi.gov and
search "NR 700 rule changes").

- The DNR is working with external volunteers to develop two issue papers on (1) fees and (2) site investigation requirements and conceptual sites models. The draft issue papers were provided in meeting materials. These issue papers are intended to identify all/any issues relating to the subject matter – with the idea that a solution could be a legislative proposal, an internal process adjustment, rulemaking, or improved communication strategies and tools. Content relating to administrative rules will help the DNR develop scope statements ahead of initiating the next rulemaking process.
- The DNR plans to initiate the next rulemaking effort in July of 2025 rather than July of 2024 based on staff capacity needed to manage both processes. This will also provide more time to develop issue papers and get EAG input on fees and site investigations and conceptual site models.

Issue Paper Discussion -

- Staff and external volunteers have drafted outlines for issue papers for two topics, then gathered input at an NR 700 Subgroup meeting and an External Advisory Group meeting. Staff and volunteers then developed outlines into full draft issue papers, which are included with the meeting materials.
- The group discussed the draft RR Program Fees and Funding Sustainability issue paper, noting that the paper lists multiple proposals as different options for approaching the issue of funding sustainability. Some options may not be advanced as final recommendations.
- The group discussed the draft Conceptual Site Models and Site Investigations issue paper, noting that the paper lists proposals that focus on different issues within a larger subject matter (rather than multiple options for addressing a single issue).
- Next steps for the issue papers include incorporating input from the meeting, adding DNR data on program fees and submittals, and prioritization and/or selection of topics for advancement at the next NR 700 Subgroup meeting.
