- Environmental Justice Subgroup. Seeking external chairperson for the EJ subgroup to continue work; the EJ chair will be supported by knowledgeable DNR staff. Email <u>Jodie.Thistle@wisconsin.gov</u> to express interest or for more information.
- Funding Sustainability Subgroup. The subgroup identified and prioritized funding gaps. Several funding gaps will be the subject of upcoming issue paper development.
 - The chair asked for input on the top priorities for which funding gaps are top priorities to add to the input received at the subgroup meeting using online poll. Comment: why are the DERF funding problems not ranked higher?
 - O Goals for the group include focusing on issue paper development, working with other EAG subgroups collaboratively, and reaching out for partnership and support. EAG members can help by volunteering for issue paper development with subgroup members and staff.

 - o Potential for legislation relating to "innocent landowners." Comment: it would be good for the EAG members to stay abreast of pending legislation.
- NR 700 Subgroup. Issue papers are in development for upcoming rulemaking topics: DNR services fees
 and site investigations and conceptual site models. The issue paper topics are selected to help DNR staff
 develop scope statements for future rulemaking; however, the issue papers are broad and address policy
 development for a range of outcomes including legislative proposals, guidance development,
 communication approaches, internal process improvements, and rulemaking.
 - Outlines of issue papers are available in the meeting materials for today's meeting. After gathering input, the outlines will be developed into full issue papers ahead of the next NR 700 Subgroup meeting and presented to the EAG at the next EAG meeting.

- Presentation: Solutions for Funding Sustainability (Fees) Molly Schmidt, Discussion about the advantages and disadvantages of the funding options that were presented.
 Discussion of the economic impact statement process and how there is opportunity for public to provide input. Comment: Recommend formal notification and opportunity for tribes to provide input on the EIS, including benefits of a rule.
- Presentation: Conceptual Site Models and Site Investigations Jodie Thistle. Discussion about requirements to define the degree and extent of contamination and how the RP needs to go beyond the property line.

- Vapor Intrusion
 - The VI Subgroup revised its draft work plan and set foundations and priorities.
 - o Going forward, the group will focus on two topics, beginning with ad hoc committee discussion:
 - Training & Outreach for Local Governments.
 - First meeting: Feb. 7, 2024 @ 11 a.m.
 - Mitigation Contractor Certification.
 - First meeting: Feb. 8, 2024 @ noon

- Other technical discussions included a DNR pilot for assigning vapor continuing obligations at interim actions, the requirement for a remedy to reduce mass and concentration when a vapor risk screening level is exceeded, the need to prioritize TCE/PCE due to acute risk, and the role of pressure field extension testing during mitigation design and commissioning. Risk-based expedited fees were also discussed.

Support of RR/NR 700 (Bill Nelson)

• Presentation and explanation of the RR program's regulatory scheme and its benefits to the regulated community are not always communicated clearly or effectively by media and news organizations. Lack of understanding of how the Wisconsin regulatory scheme differs from other states and the advantages of the WI model. One function of the EAG can be to support the program in bridging these gaps in understanding. If the RR program has interest, the EAG could explore assisting with this type of outreach through developing tools with staff. RR staff will get input on this from the RR management team.

- VI Subgroup Workplan: the subgroup has developed a workplan (included in meeting materials) and seeks approval from the EAG. Shar Te Beest moved to approve the workplan, Chris Valcheff seconded, and the EAG voted in full to approve the motion.
