#### Subgroup Updates

- Funding Sustainability Subgroup – Mark Rutkowski & Michael Prager
  - **Request for EAG Action:** Approve or provide comments, revisions or recommendations.
  - Discussion of issue paper: Vapor Contamination, Mitigation, and Stewardship Cleanup Fund.
    - Include ranking for highest risk sites, including sites with no RP (causer).
    - Include eligibility criteria to explain which sites need funding assistance.
    - Develop factors that department will consider when allocating the funds. DNR currently uses a screening process to evaluate sites and it could include something like that.
    - Consider costs to provide outreach residents to get access agreements.
    - Consider a cost recovery option to the RP
    - Define underserved communities – use various criteria for different programs. Criteria would need to be defined for this specific fund. Multi-faceted evaluation. Innocent landowner definition should also be clarified. EAG could recommend approving paper, or EAG members could seek other partners.
  - Potential future issue papers (e.g. emergency water for private wells, innocent landowners, other funding needs) and call for volunteers.

- NR 700 Subgroup – Bill Nelson & Molly Schmidt
  - The NR 700 Subgroup has standing invitations to members of the EAG and members of the public to bring policy initiatives (general policy, rulemaking, legislative) and discussion items (case studies, local laws) to meetings.

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



- RR-15-23: Definitions, land use classifications, procedures for identifying environmental standards for soil and **soil cleanup standards**.

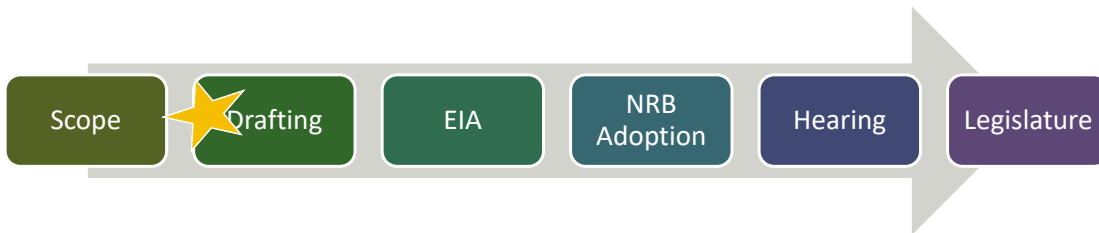

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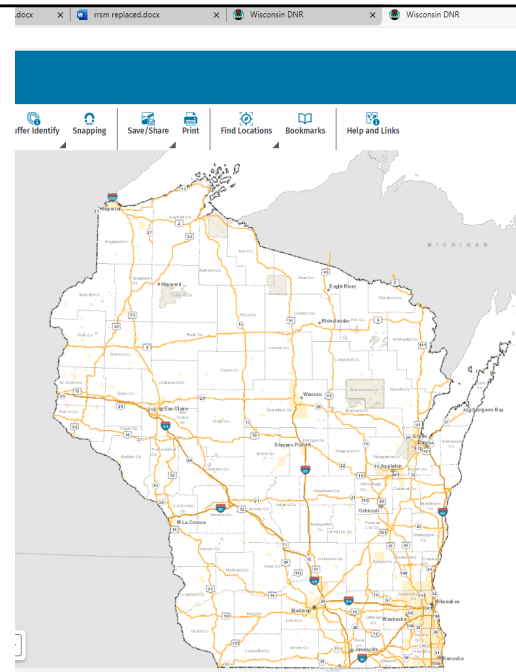

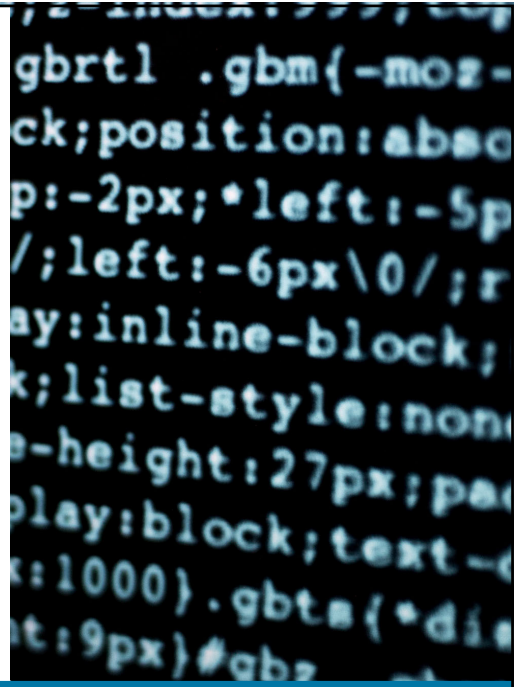

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## Vapor Intrusion Background

- PCE and TCE are chemicals that may contaminate subsurface media such as soil and groundwater.
- Health issues may arise from exposure to PCE and TCE.
- Exposure to PCE and TCE can happen indoors when off-gassing from contaminated soil or groundwater enters a building, or the building foundation contacts contamination.
- The ability for vapors from contaminated soil and groundwater to migrate and enter buildings is known as the vapor intrusion pathway.
- The vapor intrusion pathway is a potential cause of exposure to chemicals in indoor spaces.

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## Current State

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RP responsibility to address vapor intrusion at source, rights of way and affected off site properties

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Redevelopment & Brownfield Sites address vapor intrusion concerns

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Properties not on developers or municipal radar susceptible to vapor intrusion

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DNR has very limited funds from state and EPA to address sites with vapor intrusion

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Funding does not exist for most sites with vapor intrusion where there is no viable responsible party

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Concerns about long-term stewardship

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## Purpose of Cleanup Fund

- Source identification (soil, groundwater, and vapor investigations)
- Protection of building occupants
- Vapor mitigation operation, monitoring, and maintenance costs
- Long-term stewardship to maintain and monitor mitigation system
- Source cleanup and reduction

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## Potential Funding Sources

- Revitalize Wisconsin
- Capture gas tax revenue used on former PECFA program
- Lottery credits or funding
- Movement of fees for environmental programs from general fund back to WDNR
- Stand-alone program funded through legislative process
- Acquisition, cleanup, and resale of old-dog sites
- Vapor mitigation system inspection fees
- Create environmental bonding authority exclusively for environmental repair sites
- Environmental surcharges for development at non-brownfield sites
- Prime real estate development fee

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## Environmental Justice Evaluation

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- Many sites with unaddressed vapor concerns are in disadvantaged or underserved communities.
- The cleanup fund would support remediation and mitigation system operation and maintenance at all sites - not just those desirable for redevelopment.
- Fees collected as part of a prime real estate development surcharge could benefit underserved communities.

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## Resources Needed

- 2024 Assemble Bill 1055
  - Proposed elimination of existing DERF
  - Revitalize Wisconsin Program
  - Funding mechanisms for remediation and maintenance at previously closed sites
- Subgroup recommends seeking legislative support for cleanup fund

#### BACKGROUND

NR 716 language can be ambiguous or confusing; seeking to identify issues and improve clarity and regulatory efficiency.

- A. Conceptual Site Model (CSM)
  - Not explicitly named in code as a requirement although components of a CSM are required to complete a site investigation
  - Unclear when development of a CSM should begin and that it is an ongoing/living model that builds with each iteration of investigation as well as when remedial actions are taken
  - Unclear how to present a CSM as part of the SI process (format, etc.) and RAOB, RAP, closure
- B. Site Investigation Work Plan (SIWP)
  - DNR doesn't receive SIWPs for most cases, although they are required.
  - SIR does not include scoping information from NR 716.07 or info required by NR 716.09.
  - Difficult for DNR to review without adequate background information and presentation of general site conditions
- C. DNR technical review requests
  - Very few fee review requests received for SIWP, SIR, RAOB, which can result in compounding issues, less efficiency in cleanup.
  - When fee review is requested for SIWP, the responsible party (RP) may need to wait 60 days before beginning field work. But if no technical review is requested, the timeframe is 30 days, resulting in a disincentive for time-sensitive projects to seek fee review.
- D. Groundwater
  - Often when Monitored Natural Attenuation (MNA) parameters are potentially a remedy or part of a remedy, the justification of MNA is limited to decreasing contaminant concentrations, under NR 716.13(13), MNA parameters should be collected during site investigation (SI) work and should include analysis and interpretation of geochemical indicators and parameters.
  - The correct use of temp wells (wells that do not comply with NR 141 construction requirements) and grab samples as being for field screening purposes is unclear. Results are generally not considered to be representative of groundwater conditions and not to be used for regulatory compliance. Also, a temp well variance request (for wells not complying with NR 141) must be submitted prior to use for DNR review.

These draft issue papers and recommendations were developed by the Remediation and Redevelopment External Advisory Group and members of the public, and do not necessarily represent the opinions or the position of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources or other state agencies.

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

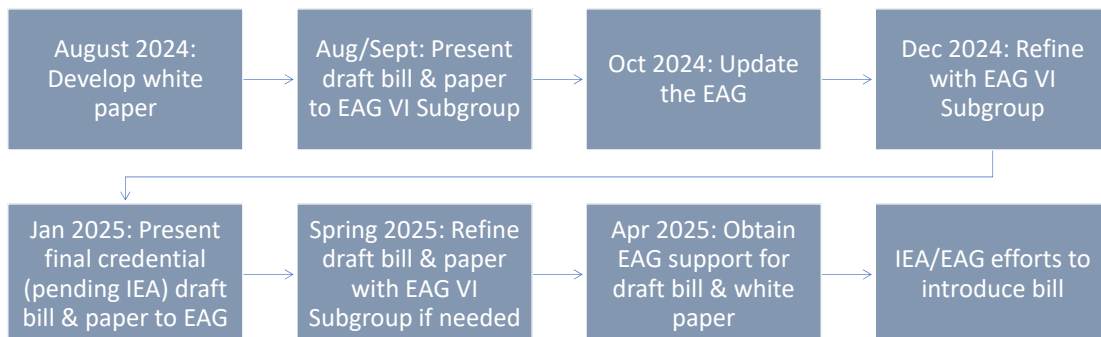

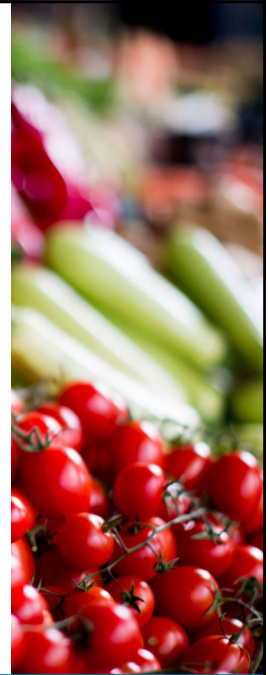
