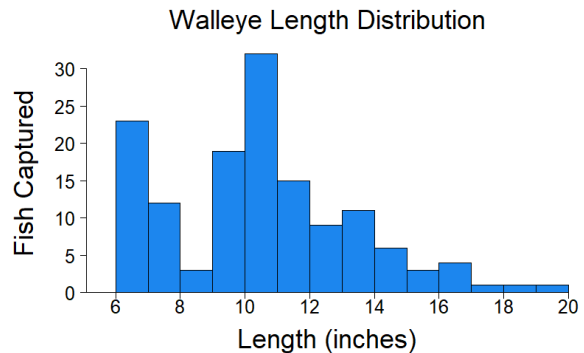
Introduction

Spillerberg Lake is a 75-acre lake with stained water and a maximum depth of 24 feet. In 2022, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) conducted a fall electrofishing survey to assess gamefish recruitment.

WALLEYE



During the fall electrofishing survey, crews captured a total of 140 walleyes at a high rate of 94.6 per mile. Walleyes ranged in length from 6.1 - 19.0 inches and averaged 10.4 inches. 35 age-0 (young-of-year) walleyes were sampled at a moderate rate of 23.3 per mile, and 69 age-1 walleyes were sampled at a high rate of 46.0 per mile. These results suggest that ample natural reproduction is occurring to support this self-sustaining population.



OTHER SPECIES

During the fall recruitment survey, crews also sampled one juvenile muskellunge.
