- Board Order DG-03-23: Proposed revisions to subch. III of ch. NR 812, related to updating, correcting and clarifying existing code requirements and adding requirements for new pump installations and water treatment and other specified code requirements.
- Board Order DG-04-23: Proposed revisions to ch. NR 146, related to water well driller, heat exchange driller, and pump installer licensing and registration, and drilling rig operator registration.

Rule Information

- Board Order DG-03-23: Chapter NR 812, Wis. Adm. Code, establishes uniform standards for the location, construction or reconstruction, maintenance and inspection of wells and water systems and heat exchange drill holes, for the filling and sealing of wells and drillholes, and for the installation and maintenance of pumping and treatment equipment. This chapter last underwent a comprehensive revision of Subchapter III focusing on pump installation in 1991. Industry standards, technology and practices have since evolved, necessitating an update to the regulatory framework to reflect current technology and best management practices for pump installation and related well construction activities. The proposed rulemaking will clarify existing requirements and address current industry practices that are not clearly articulated in code. Revisions will provide a consistent framework for the regulated community to deliver service to their customers while maintaining and improving Wisconsin's groundwater resources.
- Board Order DG-04-23: Chapter NR 146, Wis. Adm. Code, establishes rules and regulations by which the department administers water well driller, heat exchange driller, and pump installer licensing and registration. The proposed rule would address needed corrections and clarifications to the rule, address changes in administrative processes and prerequisite requirements for license eligibility, provide for automated and efficient online renewal application processing to replace the current manual processing of license renewal applications, allow for flexibility in continuing education attendance requirements and

provide additional detail in assignment of responsibility in licensed pump installer and driller contractual agreements.
