### **Rule Information:**

These rule changes are proposed for inclusion on the 2025 Wildlife Management Spring Hearing rules package and questionnaire. This rule package will modify regulations for hunting, trapping, and target shooting found in Ch's. NR 10 Game and Hunting.

Specifically, these rules may;

- 1. Allow nonedible parts of deer, bear and elk to be left in the field after harvest.
- 2. Allow the use of technology to tend traps.
- 3. Extend the fall turkey season in zones 6 and 7

4. Allow disabled hunters to hunt deer statewide while the two-day October youth firearm season is open.
