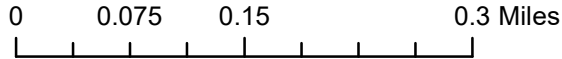

Cutting Prescription

Marked Thinning: (C.73 S.219) 3 acres.

- Harvest all trees marked with **Blue Paint**.

Clear Cut Area NO Reserves: (C.73 S.119, 146) 9 acres.

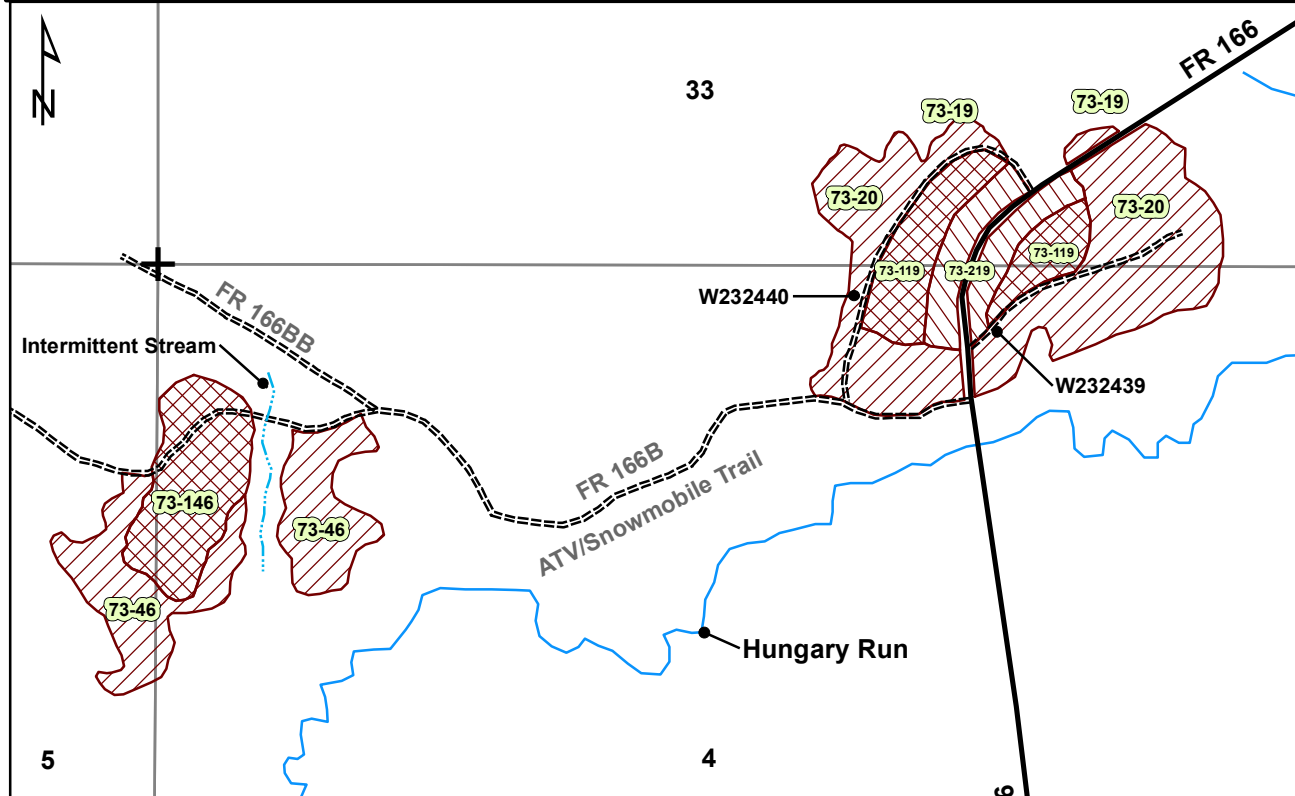
- Harvest all trees 2" and greater. Logging slash from all severed stems must be piled at a minimum of 2 piles per acre.

Clear Cut Area with Reserves: (C.73 S.19, 20, 46) 22 acres.

- Harvest all trees 2" and greater except for Oaks, Pines, Hemlock, Cedar, Yellow Birch, and trees marked with Orange Paint.

General Sale Conditions:

- Sale is bounded by **Orange Paint**. Do not harvest Orange painted trees.
- Utilization will be to a 4" top.
- Leave uncut all standing snag and den trees that do not pose a safety hazard.
- All slash shall be lopped and scattered so it lies within 2ft of the ground and kept out of wetlands within the Marked Thinning and Clear Cut Areas with Reserves.
- Maintain 10ft. wide slash-free zones along FR166, FR166B, W232439, and W232440.
- W232440 will be closed with a rock/debris berm at the intersection of FR166B following harvest by purchaser.
- FR166B doubles as an ATV/Snowmobile Trail. This trail will be closed and re-routed to recreational traffic during sale operations.
- Operability is restricted to dormant season only and may occur October 2nd through March 31st.

- Mixed Hardwood cordwood volume is estimated 60% Red Maple, 15% Yellow Birch, 13% Sugar Maple, and 12% White Birch.
- Mixed Hardwood sawtimber volume is estimated 40% Red Maple, 20% Yellow Birch, 20% White Birch, 10% Sugar Maple, and 10% Ash.
- Mixed Conifer cordwood volume is estimated 50% Cedar and 50% Hemlock.
- Sugar Maple conversion rate is 2.55 tons/cord.
- Red Maple conversion rate is 2.275 tons/cord.
- White Birch conversion rate is 2.40 tons/cord.
- Yellow Birch conversion rate is 2.675 tons/cord.

Minimum Bid Value: \$10,259.00

Harvest Requirements:

Marked Thinning: (C.73 S.219) 3 acres – Harvest all trees marked with **Blue Paint**.

Clear Cut Areas NO Reserves: (C.73 S. 119, 146) 9 acres – Harvest all trees 2” and greater. Logging slash from all severed stems must be piled at a minimum of 2 piles per acre.

Clear Cut Areas with Reserves: (C.73 S. 19, 20, 46) 22 acres – Harvest all trees 2” and greater except for Oaks, Pines, Hemlock, Cedar, Yellow Birch, and trees marked with Orange Paint.

Sale is bounded by **Orange Paint**. Do not harvest Orange painted trees.

Additional Requirements:

- **This Contract Period is Approx. 3 Years.**
- **Contract ending date is June 30th, 2027. No Contract Extensions will be awarded.**
- **Operability is restricted to dormant season only and may occur October 2nd through March 31st.**
- No bid bond required, a performance bond of 15% of the total sale bid value will be required.
- Sale will be mill scaled sale and billed using the mill ticket system.
- Utilization will be to a 4 inch top.
- Leave uncut all standing snag and den trees that do not pose a safety hazard.
- All slash shall be lopped and scattered so it lies within 2ft of the ground and kept out of wetlands within the Marked Thinning and Clear Cut Areas with Reserves.
- Maintain 10ft wide slash-free zones along FR166, FR166B, W232439, and W232440.
- W232440 will be closed with rock/debris berm following harvest at the intersection with FR166B.
- Provide for an average of 1 ruffed grouse drumming log for every 10 acres of aspen in Clear Cut Areas with Reserves. The log should be 10 or more inches in diameter and at least 12 feet long.
- Hemlock/Cedar trees required to be cut within pit footprints may be used to close temporary roads and/or used as ruffed grouse drumming logs and placed within the Clear Cut with Reserves Areas if not able to be marketed.
- Equipment must be inspected by sale administrator and clean of dirt and debris before entering sale area.
- Safety signs are required on public trails and roads entering active harvest areas.

Road and Skid Trails:

- All landings and skid trails should be blocked to vehicular access and possibly re-seeded at the conclusion of use if needed.
- FR166B doubles as an ATV/Snowmobile Trail. This trail will be closed and re-routed to recreational traffic during sale operations.
- Invasive plant populations occur along the corridor of FR166 and FR166B. No decking on FR166 will be allowed. Avoidance of established invasive plant populations along FR166B will reduce the chance for further infestation and spread. Designated placement of log piles along the corridor will be cleared of visible populations of invasive plants.
- All road maintenance and rehabilitation post-harvest is the purchaser's responsibility. A sample contract including road maintenance specifications can be obtained by request.
