Sieverson Springs East Timber Sale (Tract 8004-1-24)

162 Acres

Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest Section 24 & 25; T39N R3E; Price County, WI (Town of Fifield)

Birch Shelterwood Area (54 acres)

Area bounded by orange paint, red paint, and natural wetland edge.

Harvest all trees 1" dbh and larger except for: 1) aspen, 2) yellow birch, 3) oak, 4) all conifers other than balsam fir, and 5) orange marked trees.

Aspen Coppice Area (45 acres)

Area bounded by orange paint, red paint, and natural wetland edge.

Harvest all trees 2" dbh and larger except for: 1) yellow birch, 2) oak, 3) all conifers other than balsam fir, and 4) orange marked trees.

Hardwood Selection Area (40 acres); Canopy Gaps (20 gaps, 2 acres total area)

Area bounded by orange paint and natural wetland edge. Harvest: 1) blue marked trees and 2) 1-stick and larger balsam fir.


Canopy Gaps bounded by purple paint (V-shapes face into gaps; dots face outside).

Within Gaps, Harvest all trees 1" dbh and larger except for: 1) cedar, 2) hemlock, and 3) purple marked trees.

Conifer Release Area (21 acres)

Area bounded by orange paint and natural wetland edge.

Harvest all trees 2" dbh and larger except for: 1) all conifers including balsam fir, 2) yellow birch, 3) oak, 4) orange marked trees.

¹Mixed Hardwood Pulp includes 45% white birch, 45% red maple, and 10% hard maple (with small amounts of ash and other species).

²Mixed Hardwood Saw includes 23 MBF red maple and 2 MBF hard maple.

Other species not mentioned will be charged at the Mixed Hardwood Pulp or Saw price, accordingly.

- 1) Bids must meet or exceed the total minimum acceptable bid of \$36,665.00.
- 2) Each species/product must be bid on (per ton or MBF).
- 3) A bid will be rejected if any individual species/product bid is \$0.
- 4) Cordwood weight conversion factors are as follows:

Mixed Hardwood = 2.400 Aspen = 2.250 Balsam Fir = 2.125

Paint Color Scheme:

- Blue: Trees to be harvested. Cut all blue marked trees.
- Orange: Sale/stand boundary and reserve/leave trees. Do not cut any orange marked trees.
- Red: Property boundary trees. Do not cut any red marked trees or cross onto private property.
- Purple: Canopy gap boundary and reserve/leave trees. Do not cut any purple marked trees.

Seasonal Restrictions:

Harvesting operations on 108 acres are limited to <u>frozen ground conditions only.</u>
 This includes all harvest areas except for the Birch Shelterwood Area, which can be harvested any time as long as the ground is not saturated.

Harvest Requirements:

- Contract ending date will be **June 30, 2027** (allowing 3 winter seasons to complete).
- Harvest boundaries include orange paint line, red paint line, and natural wetland edge.
- No machine operation allowed outside of orange or red boundary paint line, or in adjacent wetland areas.
- The harvesting of any portion of a tree that lies outside the physical ownership of the Forest Service will not be allowed. Trees lying across the property line must be bucked at the ownership line and all portions of the tree that reside on the private side of the line must be left in place. Conversely, the remaining portion of the tree that lies within the physical ownership of the Forest Service may be harvested and utilized.

- No bond is required with bid on this timber sale. A performance bond of 15% of the total bid value will be required within 6 weeks of announcement of successful bidder.
- Sale will be mill scale using a 30-day billing period.
- Equipment must be cleaned and inspected by DNR staff before entering and leaving the sale area to prevent the introduction and spread of invasive species.

Slash Requirements:

- A 10-foot slash removal zone shall be applied to areas adjacent to the red paint boundary line denoting private property.
- Do not pile slash within riparian or other wetland areas.

Road/Trail Requirements:

- DOT approved signage is required to be placed on Sheep Ranch Road (FR 132) near the intersection of FR 521 during harvest and hauling operations for safety reasons.
- Decking of wood along FR 521 is permitted. If decking is desired along Sheep Ranch Road, written permission must be obtained by the Town of Fifield.

Additional Requirements:

- NO SALE MAY BEGIN WITHOUT PRIOR NOTIFICATION AND AN ON-SITE MEETING WITH A WISCONSIN DNR SALE ADMINISTRATOR.
- Keep all logging debris and machine operations within sale boundaries.
- Leave all standing snag and cull/den trees that do not pose a safety hazard. If needed to remove as a safety precaution, cut and leave lay on the ground.
- New temporary roads, stubs, or turn-arounds will need approval by the timber sale administrator and may require berms/slash.
- Proposed/Temporary Roads shall have the road base constructed to a width of 12 feet or narrower, and with vegetative clearing of trees and brush not to exceed a width of 25 feet. Exceptions to the 12-foot maximum width of the road base may be granted by the sale administrator for operational reasons.
- Any roads that are used other than FR 521 may require a berm or slash covering them for decommissioning purposes. When constructing berms, do not dig a depression that will collect and hold water.
 - o **Proposed Berm** shall be constructed using logging debris which includes any combination of dirt mixed with rocks, stumps, logs, root-wads, and/or slash.
 - o **Proposed Berm** shall be constructed without creating a defined trench.
 - o **Proposed Berm** shall be at least 4-5 feet in height from ground level.
- All road maintenance and post-harvest rehabilitation will be the purchaser's responsibility. A sample contract including road maintenance specifications can be obtained upon request.
