
Brule River State Forest



- 1.Sale boundaries marked in red paint, blue paint, or bounded by roads. Blue paint indicates private property lines and shall not be crossed with equipment or felled trees.
- 2. <u>Marked Pine Cutting Unit</u>: Cut all Balsam Fir 4 inches DBH and larger as well as all trees marked with orange paint.
- 3. South Cutting Unit: Cut all Aspen and Ash 4 inches DBH and larger.
- 4. **North Cutting Unit**: Cut all Aspen, Ash, Balsam Fir, Spruce, and Maple 4 inches DBH and larger. EXCEPTION: Leave all Maple and Spruce 12 inches DBH and larger.
- 3. Utilize all cut trees to <u>bid utilization size</u> (whole tree or 4 inch top) Utilize any cut trees which contain one or more 100 inch stick to a 4 inch minimum top diameter. Any trees not designated for harvest shall be left uncut and undamaged. Slash height may not exceed 3 feet.
- 4. New road or landing construction must be approved by sale administrator. Suggested access routes are shown on the map. Any permits needed for waterway crossing shall be acquired by DNR.
