

- 1. Sale boundaries marked in red paint, blue paint or bounded by obvious roads/trails.
- 2. <u>Cut all red pine, maple, oak, aspen, and jack pine that are not marked with green paint.</u> Dead snags not deemed to be dangerous shall be left uncut and undamaged.
- 3. Utilize all cut trees which contain one or more 100" stick to a 4-inch top diameter. Slash height must not exceed three feet in depth nor longer than eight feet in length and must be spread evenly over site.
- 4. From May 15 through August 15 all cut pine products must be hauled off site within 2 weeks of harvest to mitigate pine bark beetle concerns. No use of snowmobile trail while it is open for snowmobile use.
- 4. New road and/or landing construction must be approved by property manager or contract administrator.
