

- 1. Sale Boundaries marked by blue paint, red paint, roads, or obvious type changes.
- 2. <u>Thinning:</u> Cut all trees marked in orange paint. <u>Clearcut:</u> Cut all trees 2 DBH and larger.
- 3. Utilize all cut trees which contain one or more 100" stick to a 4" top diameter. Slash height must not exceed three feet in depth nor longer than 8 feet in length and must be spread evenly over site.
- 4. From May 15 through August 15 all cut pine products must be hauled off site within 2 weeks of harvest to mitigate pine bark beet concerns.
- 5. New road and/or landing construction must be approved by property manager or contract administrator.

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
