BIDDING REQUIREMENTS

1. Bidding Procedure for Timber Sales
 - a. Bids will be made by species for each tract.
 - b. Estimated volumes and utilization specifications are listed on individual sale prospectus maps. Bid according to volumes listed on individual sale prospectus and/or maps.
 - c. The **high bidder** will be determined by the **greatest total bid** for each tract.
 - d. Bids will be opened in random order.

- e. **Bidders in attendance (virtual)** can remove their bid from consideration before each individual tract is opened. Bidders must identify themselves by clearly stating their name, address, and telephone number PRIOR to a bid being opened to withdraw their bid from consideration.
2. Bids may be made on one or more tracts.
 3. Submit each bid in an **individual sealed envelope** marked “Bid for Timber Stumpage” with the timber sale name, and tract number on the outside. Wisconsin DNR Timber Sale Bid Forms must be used to make bids on DNR timber sales and is included with the individual sale prospectus
 4. A per unit bid must be made on every item on a tract. No “zero” bids for any species or products will be accepted.
 5. Winning bidders will be notified within 24 hours of bid opening and **must sign the timber sale contract and submit an acceptable performance bond within 6 weeks of the bid opening.** If the winning bidder fails to execute the contract and submit an acceptable performance bond, the bidder shall be required to forfeit to the department an amount equal to 10% of the total bid amount. Failure to forfeit the 10% penalty will result in the bidder being considered ineligible to bid on any state or GNA timber sales for a two-year period.
 6. A **Performance Bond or Letter of Credit** is required before awarding of contract. The bond shall be fifteen percent (15%) of the total bid value or a minimum of \$1000.00, whichever is greater. The bond will be held intact by the Department of Natural Resources until the satisfactory completion of the timber sale contract. Performance bonds in a form of other than cash for these sales must expire no earlier than **1-year past contract expiration date.**
 7. The Department of Natural Resources reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

SALES TAX CERTIFICATION

1. A [Sales and Use Tax Exemption Certificate](https://www.revenue.wi.gov/DORForms/s-211-inst.pdf) must be provided at the signing of the contract. This certificate is required to cover a contractor or individual reselling stumpage harvested for firewood/fuelwood and mills and manufacturing facilities. UTILIZATION

1. All trees designated for cutting will be utilized to a 4” small-end diameter for pulp; 11” small-end diameter for logs unless stated otherwise in the prospectus.
2. When designated for cutting, all trees containing one (1) or more one hundred inch (100”) long stick to a four inch (4”) minimum top diameter will be considered merchantable.

SCALING AND PAYMENT

1. If eligible for deferred payment option, payment for timber removed from site must be made within 30 days after invoice.
2. If not eligible for deferred payment option, no wood will be hauled from the sale area until advanced payment is made.
3. If sold as a lump sum sale, payment in full must be made on entire sale, or by the cutting block, or by some other means as mutually agreed upon by Department of Natural Resources and contractor.
4. The mill scale ticket system will be used as the preferred method of sale administration. Other scaling systems may be used at the discretion of the Department of Natural Resources.
5. If a woods scale system is used, all cordwood or logs will be piled for scaling. Piles will be level and square with at least 10 cords per pile or 5 MBF. At least 20 cords 10 MBF will be piled before a scale is requested. Scaling requests must be made at least one day in advance.

6. No refunds of stumpage payments will be made for un-removed wood, and wood left on the sale area at contract expiration shall revert to the seller.
7. Scribner Decimal C Log Rule shall be used for scaling logs. Conversion from MBF to cords or cords to MBF shall be 2.44 cords per MBF for softwoods and 2.2 cords per MBF for hardwoods.
8. Weight scale conversions will be at rates as specified in the Department of Natural Resources timber sale handbook listed below unless the individual timber sale has specific mixed species pro-rates/conversions.

CONTRACT PERIOD

1. The contracts offered in this bid letting will be either 2+ or 3+ years in length. The contract expiration date for each sale is listed on the prospectus for that sale. Prospective bidders should be sure to review the contract end date for each sale.

CONTRACT EXTENSIONS

Contract extensions will not be granted without justifiable reason. Justification will be determined by the Department of Natural Resources. Contract expiration dates are given on the individual timber sale. Contract extensions are not guaranteed. All extensions, if granted, will be for 1 year. Extension requests will be considered with the following conditions:

One and Two-year contracts

- 1st extension – 5% increase in stumpage rate
- 2nd extension – an additional 10% increase in stumpage rate

Three and Four-year Contracts

- 1st extension – 15% increase in stumpage rate (only 1 extension granted)

OTHER CONDITIONS

- Wisconsin’s Best Management Practices for Water Quality, Woody Biomass Harvesting Guidelines, and Best Management Practices for Invasive Species must be followed on all DNR timber sales. More information on these management guidelines can be found at the links found below:

- Pine sales may include a requirement for treating cut stumps to control Heterobasidion Root Disease (HRD). If HRD treatment is required, the following provisions will apply:
 - Purchaser will be responsible for supplying an approved fungicide and completing preventive treatment if cutting of pine occurs between April 1 and Nov. 30.
 - Treatment must be performed by a Certified Pesticide Applicator.
 - All fresh-cut stumps of pines and spruce of merchantable size shall be treated by applying either CELLU-TREAT (disodium octaborate tetrahydrate) or Rotstop C (*Phlebiopsis gigantea*).
 - Treatment shall be made as soon as possible and no later than one day after harvest.
 - A dye product shall be added to liquid solutions for inspection purposes.

Insurance

The “Contractor” (purchaser) shall provide the Department of Natural Resources with a Certificate of Insurance counter-signed by a Wisconsin Resident Agent, indicating that Worker’s Compensation Insurance coverage is provided for the duration of the contract prior to any performance under it. Contractor claiming exemption, independent status, the contractor/purchaser will be required to submit a signed, notarized affidavit that affirms their exempt status pursuant to the criteria listed in section 102.07(7)(b), of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Contract may contain other provisions. Contracts may not be assigned. A sample copy of the contract is available upon request.

Unit 1- Select cut area, approx. 48 acres, cut all orange marked trees. Area is bound by red paint, blue paint, or fields. Avoid damaging oak regeneration where found, particularly near field edges.

Unit 2- Aspen regeneration area, approximately 3 acres. Cut all stems greater than 2” except do not cut retention trees marked by green paint. Area is bound by green paint which ties into blue line or red line, do not cut boundary marker trees.

Operational Considerations-

- Oak wilt: no harvest or road building activity permitted 1 April -July 15 annually.
- All conifer products must be moved from landing within 2 weeks if cut between July 15 – August 15
- Access, landings and main skid trails must be approved by forester prior to work beginning.
- Roads and parking areas will be maintained to their original condition.
- Slash will be lopped and scattered to less than 3’ from ground, and if it falls into ponds/wetlands, must be pulled back.
- Contract will run for 2.5 years (Dec 31st, 2024)

- Access will require dry or frozen conditions. If rutting occurs, activity will be halted until conditions improve.
- Borders with private lands have some existing fence-lines. Contractor accepts liability if improvements are damaged during harvest activities.
- Do not cut boundary trees marked with blue, red, yellow or green. Purple is irrelevant to sale and may be cut if also marked by orange.
- Stumps will be no higher than 10" or the diameter of the stump, whichever is less. Cut off ends and debris must be taken from landing area back into woods on completion.
- No mechanical operations in areas bound by yellow paint.
- Volumes were calculated using point sampling and estimates made utilizing 4" cordwood standards. Volumes are not guaranteed, and allowances will not be made for over or under runs. Bolt % estimates are also not guaranteed.
- This area has invasive species. Equipment required to be free of plants/soils upon entering and leaving site.
- Proof of insurance and FISTA training required before work begins.

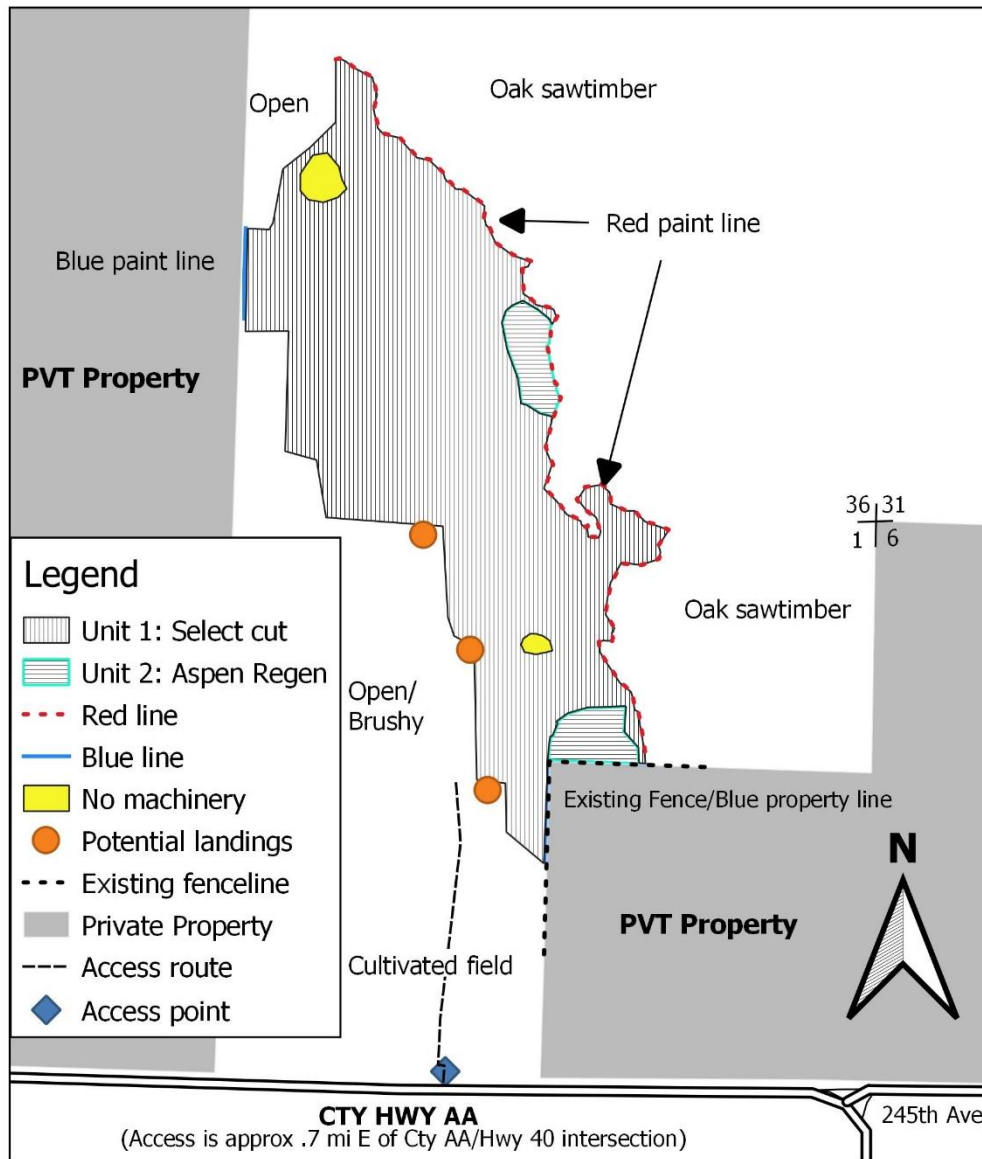


Figure 1. This map is not a survey of the actual boundary of any property this map depicts. Mapped by RMP, 9/9/22. Scale 1:7920

Unit 1- (17 ac) Marked pine thinning. Harvest all orange marked trees. Approx. 4 acres is first thinning pine, rest is mixed age. 3.9 acre parcel in west is not required to be harvested for sale to be considered complete. Bounded by red, blue, or clear cover type transitions.

Unit 2- (4 ac) Aspen coppice harvest. Cut all stems >1" in diameter except those marked in green. Area is bound by blue line, red line, or clear cover type transitions.

Unit 3: (<1 acre) Pine removal area. Harvest all stems in this area >1" in diameter except red boundary line trees.

Operational Considerations-

- Access is limited to frozen ground conditions between 1 Nov – Apr 15. Access is through a rented crop field, and all debris must be cleared from fields. Skid trails and landing sites must be approved by DNR Forester before work begins.
- Access may require 2-3 timber mats. Coordination can be made to use mats owned by state, or provide own.
- All roads and landings will be closed to satisfaction of seller upon harvest completion by building bunkers or blocking access with large rocks. All access and roads will be maintained to original pre-harvest conditions.
- Rutting will be monitored and harvest operations may be suspended if disturbances are in excess of those allowed in contract.

- Slash will be lopped and scattered to less than 3' in height. If tops fall in wetland areas, they must be removed and pulled back into sale area. No limbs/tops will be left hanging in tree tops.
- Boundary to North and West include shared fence-lines with neighbors. Contractor assumes liability for any damage caused to these fences through harvest activities. You may consider the areas marked with "blue-line" on map to have existing boundary fence.

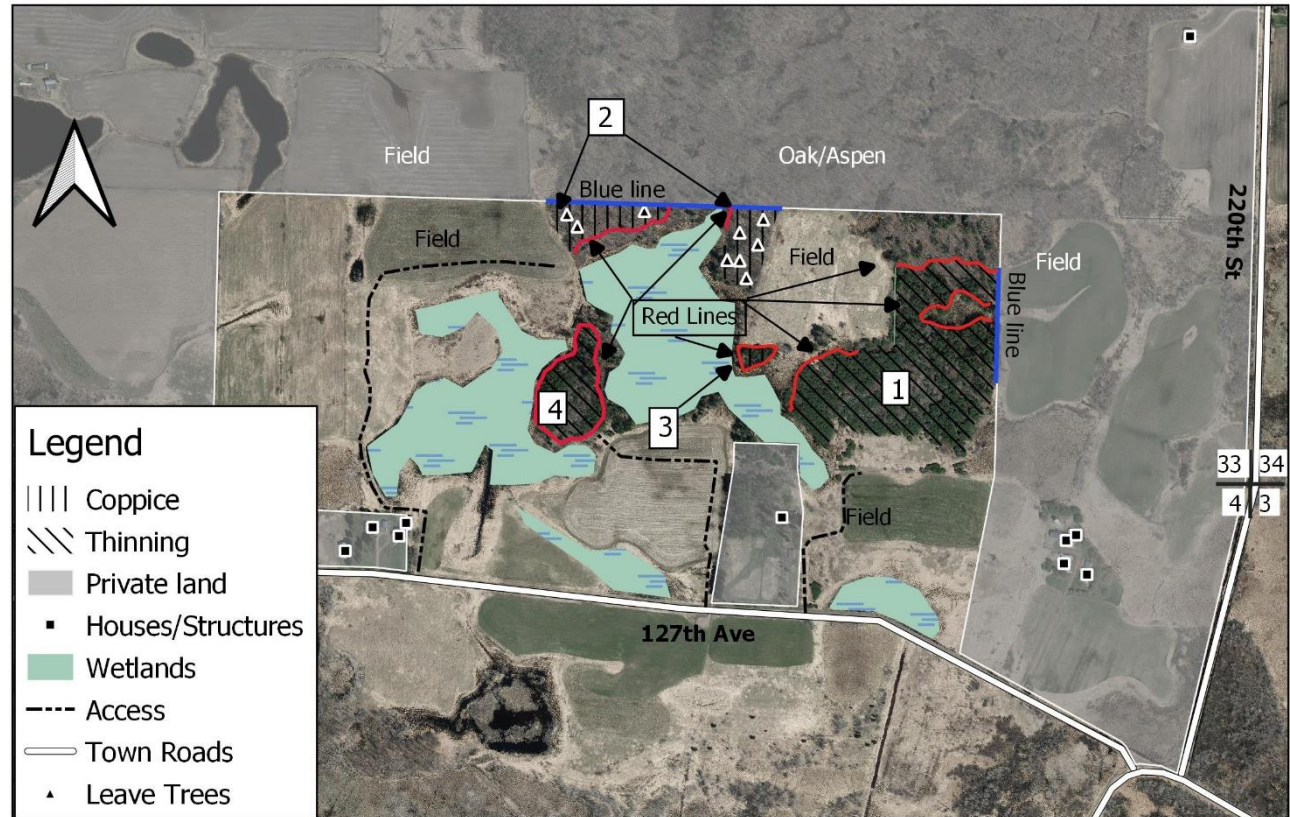

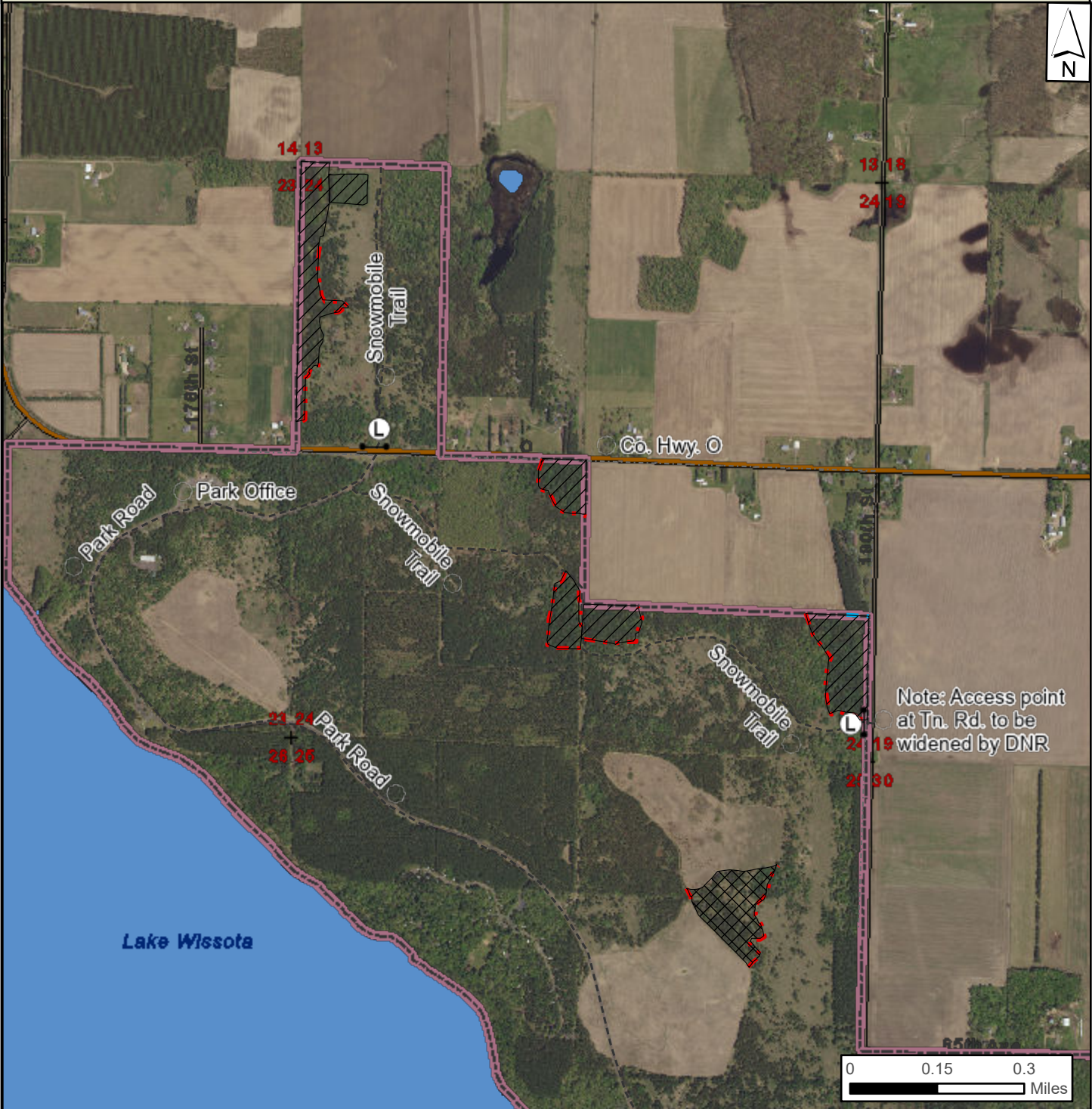

Jack Pine Clearcut - Cut all trees 1" DBH and larger within the designated harvest area.

Operational Considerations

*Access to all harvest areas will use existing snowmobile trail as primary haul route. Landing area and skid route locations must be approved by the property manager.
