

Tract 8-23 (Dangled Web Sale) – Flambeau River State Forest

Parts of: NWSW Sec. 7, T37N-R3W; NE, N1/2SE, S1/2 SW Sec. 12; NENW Sec. 13, T37N-R4W
Town of Winter, Sawyer County



Selection Area (44 acres) – Bounded by red paint line. Harvest all orange marked trees within the designated boundaries. Sever all orange marked unmerchantable stems (canopy gaps). Leave, do not cut 1) snags, 2) cull trees, 3) trees marked with an orange X. Cut only **marked** aspen. **Purple Gap (<0.5 acres)** – Bounded by purple paint. Cut all trees greater than 1” except for: 1) white pine, 2) hemlock, or 3) purple “x” marked trees.



Aspen/Red Maple Area (31 acres) – Bounded by yellow and blue paint. Harvest all trees greater than 2 inches except for: 1) white pine, 2) hemlock, 3) oak, 4) red pine, 5) cedar, 6) spruce with 2 sticks or less, or 7) “x” marked trees.

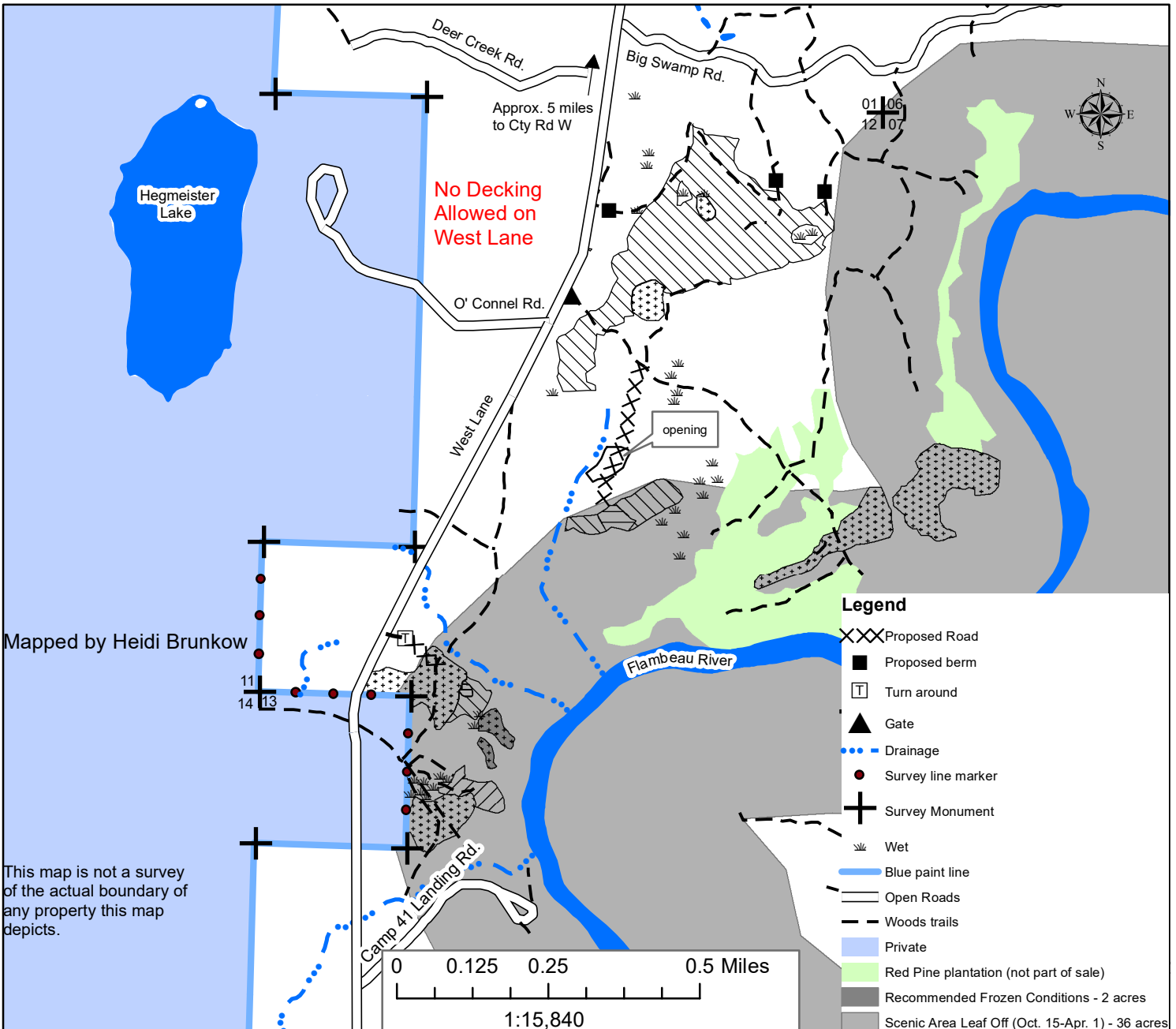


Red Pine Thinning (5 acres) – Bounded by red paint. Cut all trees marked with orange paint. Cut **marked** aspen only.



Overstory Removal (1 acres) – Bounded by yellow paint. Cut all trees greater than 5” except for: 1) white pine, 2) hemlock, or 3) oak. ****Protect existing regeneration.****

Total Acres: 81
