

- Hardwood Thinning (99 acres): Harvest all trees marked with orange paint.
 Also harvest all merchantable aspen, ironwood, and balsam fir. Canopy gaps have been designated with purple paint. Cut all stems inside the canopy gaps that are larger than 2". Do not harvest trees marked with purple paint.
- <u>Aspen Coppice (77 acres):</u> Harvest all trees 2" and larger except oak, pine, spruce, hemlock, cedar, yellow birch, and any tree marked with green paint.
- <u>Hardwood Coppice (1 acre)</u>: Harvest all trees 2" and larger inside the purple boundary paint. Use caution to protect established saplings.

General Sale Conditions:

- Contract end date June 30th, 2026
- Ticket scale sale
- Excessive rutting or damage to residual trees will result in suspension of logging activities
- Sale boundaries marked with red paint or unmarked using natural boundaries
- Care must be taken to preserve all survey monuments
- Retain all suitable snag and den trees that do not pose a safety hazard
- Reserve all red marked boundary trees

- Utilize all trees to a 4-inch minimum top
- Scatter all slash and cut to within 2 feet of the ground
- New roads, trails and landings must be approved by the sale administrator

- Equipment must be clean before entering sale area
- Whitetail Trail must be kept clear and free of debris during harvesting and hauling operations
- All landings and access points shall be returned to original condition when sale is completed
- Cautionary signage shall be posted on Whitetail Trail and Hoffman Lake Road.
