Equipment use is restricted to dry or frozen ground conditions.

No cutting during the months of April, May, or June in selection areas due to bark being easily damaged at these times.

All slash and ends must be removed from the ATV/Snowmobile trail with each truckload. No slash may be left on the ski trail.

Slash within 100 feet of ATV/Snowmobile trail and ski trail must be lopped and scattered to within two feet of the ground. No slash may be left within 20 feet of the ski trail.

While operating equipment or felling trees within 100 feet of the ski trail, extreme caution must be taken. For safety and to minimize debris, trees should be felled away from the trail.

For safety, the Department may temporarily close the trail while sale operations are within 100 feet of the ski trail.

Written permission from sale administrator is required before any equipment use is allowed on the ski trail. Any soil disturbance must be immediately repaired.

Tower Hill Road is also a snowmobile trail. Three inches of snow will be left on the snowmobile trail and Tower Hill Rd, weather permitting.
