Equipment use will be restricted to very dry or frozen ground conditions.

Decking on Rock Creek Road would have to be approved by the township of Lake. Small back-ins will be permitted for decking off Rock Creek Road.

Harvesting is permitted outside of April 1st to June 30th due to easily damaged bark between these months

If decking on Rock Creek Road or Hunter/Walking Trail, all slash and ends will be removed from the road and ditches concurrently with each truckload.

To make areas of sale operable during dry conditions, existing trails and new stub roads will most likely need pit run material. The state will provide the pit run material, but it will be the responsibility of the contractor for loading/hauling/leveling any pit run needed for decking on these existing roads and new stubs. Culvert placement will be evaluated and completed by the state.

No slash will be left in the ditch lines of Rock Creek Road or Hunter Walking Trail. No slash will be allowed on or within 10 feet of the graded town road. Slash within 100 feet of Rock Creek Road will be lopped and scattered within 2 feet of the ground.
