

**Tract 8-24 (Long Spoon) – Flambeau River State Forest**

Parts of: S1/2 NW, S1/2 NE, NESE, SW1/4 Sec. 6, T 38N-R3W, Town of Winter, Sawyer County



**Selection Area (95 acres)** – Bounded by red paint and blue paint. Harvest all orange marked trees. Sever all orange marked unmerchantable stems. Leave all snags. *Protect existing regeneration.*

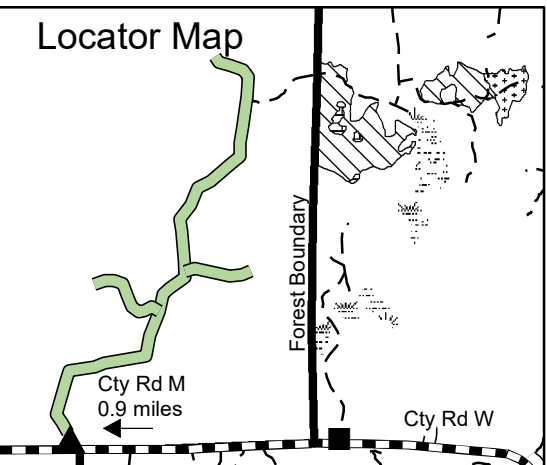
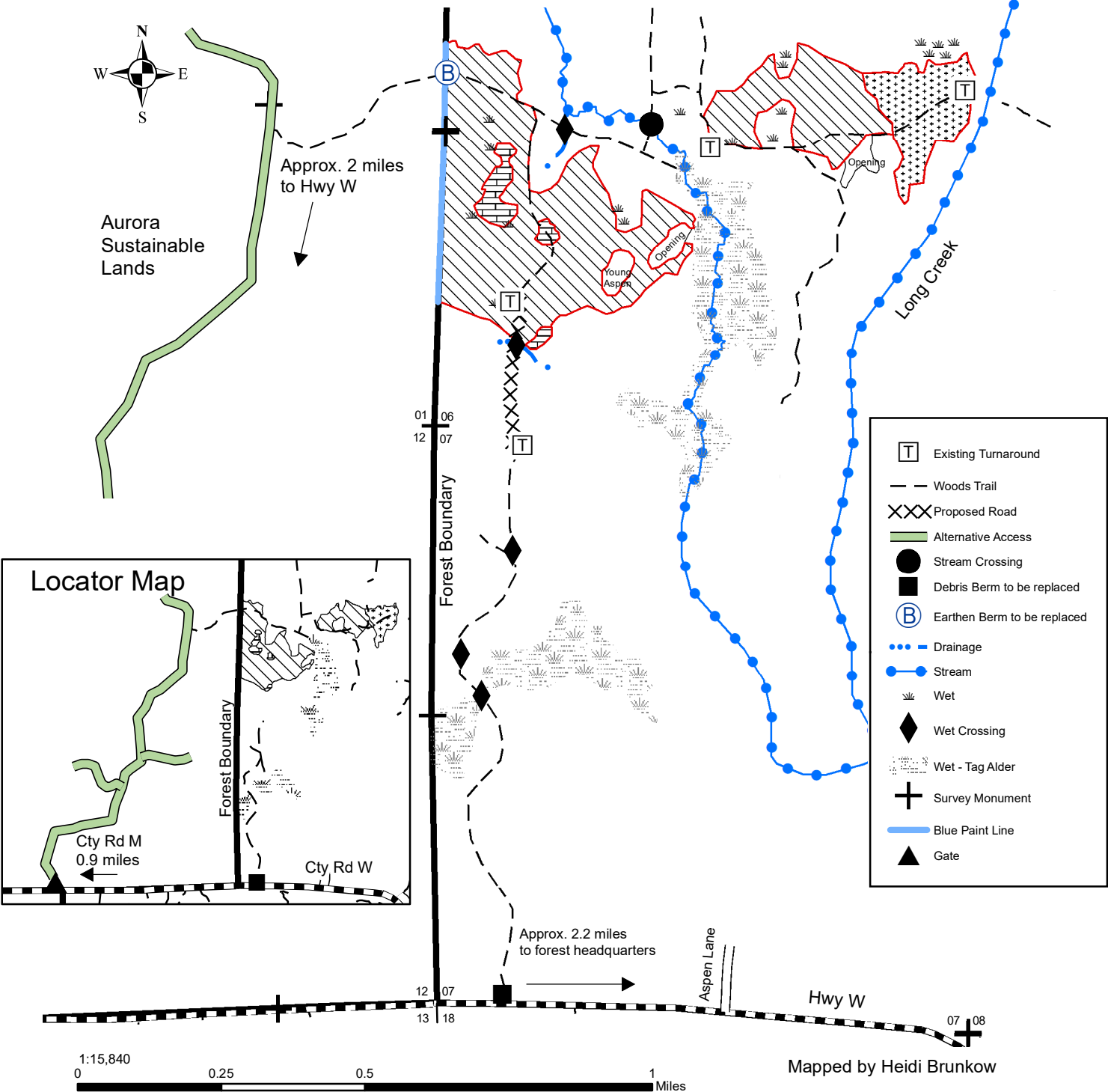


**Black Ash/Red Maple Coppice Area (16 acres)** – Bounded by red paint. Cut all trees greater than 2” except for: 1) cedar, 2) hemlock, 3) white pine, 4) oak, 5) yellow birch, and 6) snags.



**Aspen Coppice Area (5 acres)** – Bounded by red paint. Cut all trees greater than 2” except for: 1) hemlock, 2) white pine, 3) oak, and 4) snags.
