<sup>2</sup>Mixed softwood includes 83% spruce, 14% tamarack, and 3% balsam.

Other species not mentioned will be charged at the mixed hardwood price.

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The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. **The contract end date is June 30, 2028**

**SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:**

Equipment use will be allowed when the ground is very dry or frozen due to wet soil conditions.

Access to private parcels and the canoe campsite must always be kept clear.

If decking on Cedar Rapids Rd, trails that access private parcels, or the canoe campsite access road, all slash, ends, and debris must be removed from the roads and ditches concurrently with each truckload.

No turn arounds will be allowed south of the selection area.

Logging damage to the gate is the responsibility of the contractor and must be repaired prior to moving off the sale.

Landing size will not exceed 100' by 200'.

To make areas of sale operable during dry conditions, existing trails and new stub roads will most likely need pit run material. The state will provide the pit run material, but it will be the responsibility of the contractor for loading/hauling/leveling any pit run needed for decking on these existing roads and new stubs.

Winter Township does not allow decking on West Lane.
