

Cutting Requirements/Information

Thinning (Blocks C and F) – Block C harvest all red pine that is marked with orange paint. Block F is an unmarked 1st thinning, harvest 1 row leave 2 rows.



Clearcut with Reserves (Block E and G) - Clearcut, harvest all trees with one or more sticks except orange marked trees in E and bur oak in Block G

- Hardwood Utilization: 4" top DIB. Pine Utilization: 6" top DIB. All pine meeting the definition of a pulp stick (4" DIB at 100") shall be, at minimum, lopped at 100" and scattered as slash if not being removed from the harvest area.
- 2. Do not harvest paint marked boundary trees.
- Maximum stump height shall be 10 inches. 3.

Landings

- Slash shall be kept within the sale boundaries and scattered with a maximum height not to exceed 3 feet. Reduce the slash in block E to 2 feet and 4. do not pile slash near the marked leave trees.
- Landings shall be approved by the Department prior to their construction. Progressive short wood landings are permitted along existing woods 5. roads.
- All existing roads and trails shall be kept open to allow for normal use throughout the harvest. 6.
- Harvesting shall be completed in a systematic and progressive manner. Harvest blocks shall be completely harvested prior to harvesting in another 7. block, unless otherwise approved by the Department.
- Leave all snags where they are not a safety risk to the operators.
- All pine in piles between May 15 and August 15 shall be removed from the landings within 21 days.
- Do not damage advanced regeneration or trees not designated for harvest.
