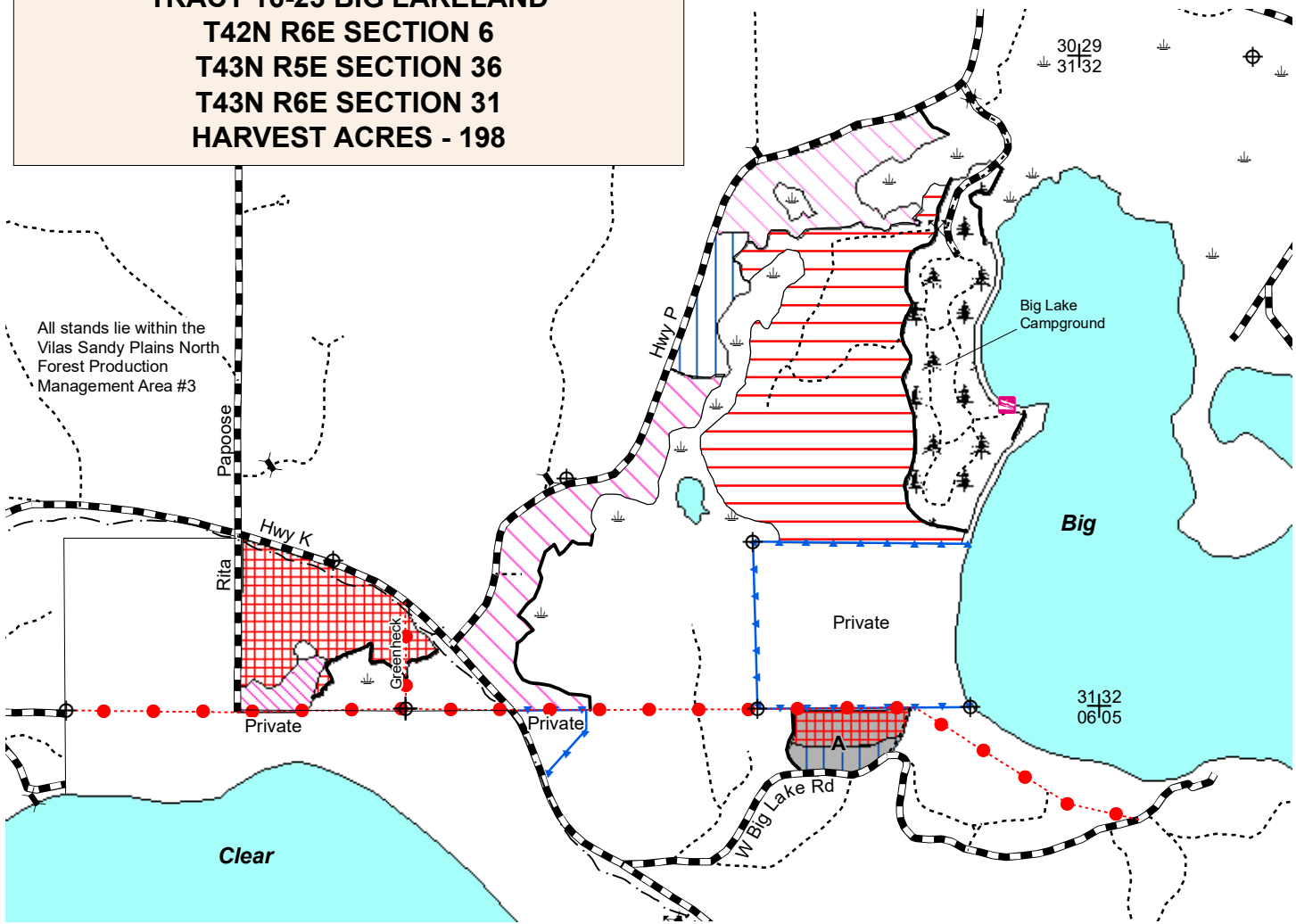

- Pine (45 Acres): Cut all aspen, balsam fir, maple, white birch and orange marked trees.
- Red Pine First Thinning (12 Acres): Cut all aspen, balsam fir, maple, white birch and orange marked trees.
- Pine/Aspen (73 Acres): Cut all aspen, balsam fir, maple, white birch and orange marked trees.
Harvesting in the Pine/Aspen stand and Zone A allowed only between October 1 and April 14.
- Big Lake Campground (35 Acres): Cut all merchantable aspen, white birch and orange marked trees. Do not cut trees within 50 feet of Big Lake unless marked with orange paint.
Harvesting operations in campground allowed only during frozen and snow covered ground conditions.
- Red Pine Thinning (29 Acres): Cut all aspen, maple, white birch and orange marked trees.
- Hardwoods (4 Acres): Cut orange marked trees.

Note: Do NOT cut trees marked with green paint. Harvesting operations allowed July 16 to April 14.

The cutting area is approximately 198 acres.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

Total Minimum Bid Value \$ 66,850.00

1 Approximately 56% red pine, 44% white pine and <1% jack pine. Included is an estimated 203 MBF of sawlog material.

2 Approximately 78% balsam fir and 22% white spruce. Included is an estimated 4 MBF of sawlog material.

3 Included is an estimated 25 MBF of sawlog material.

4 Approximately 52% red maple, 46% white birch and 2% sugar maple. Included is an estimated 14 MBF of sawlog material.

Total sale volume equates to 29.5 tons/acre or 12.8 cords/acre.

Special Conditions:

1. Harvesting operations allowed between July 16th and April 14th. Harvesting operations in Zone A and the Pine/Aspen stand allowed between October 1st and April 14th.
2. All slash within 50 feet of any road or trail must be lopped and scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting.
3. **Big Lake Campground**
 - a. **Harvesting operations allowed only during frozen ground and snow-covered conditions.**
 - b. **Cut down all dead trees in and around the campground, dump station and boat landing.**
 - c. **Slash management – Lop and scatter slash to lie within two feet of the ground.**
4. Special considerations must be taken into account when harvesting within 100 feet of the paved bike trail for safety and trail protection. Contractor shall communicate with DNR Forester to make a plan for harvesting near the paved bike trail.
5. Decking wood along paved state forest roads permitted with forester approval.
6. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.

Notice: Completion of this form is mandatory. The Department will not recognize your bid unless you complete and submit this form. In the event the highest bidder can not or will not sign the contract, the award may be made to the next highest qualified bid.
