Cut all maple, balsam fir, and orange marked trees.

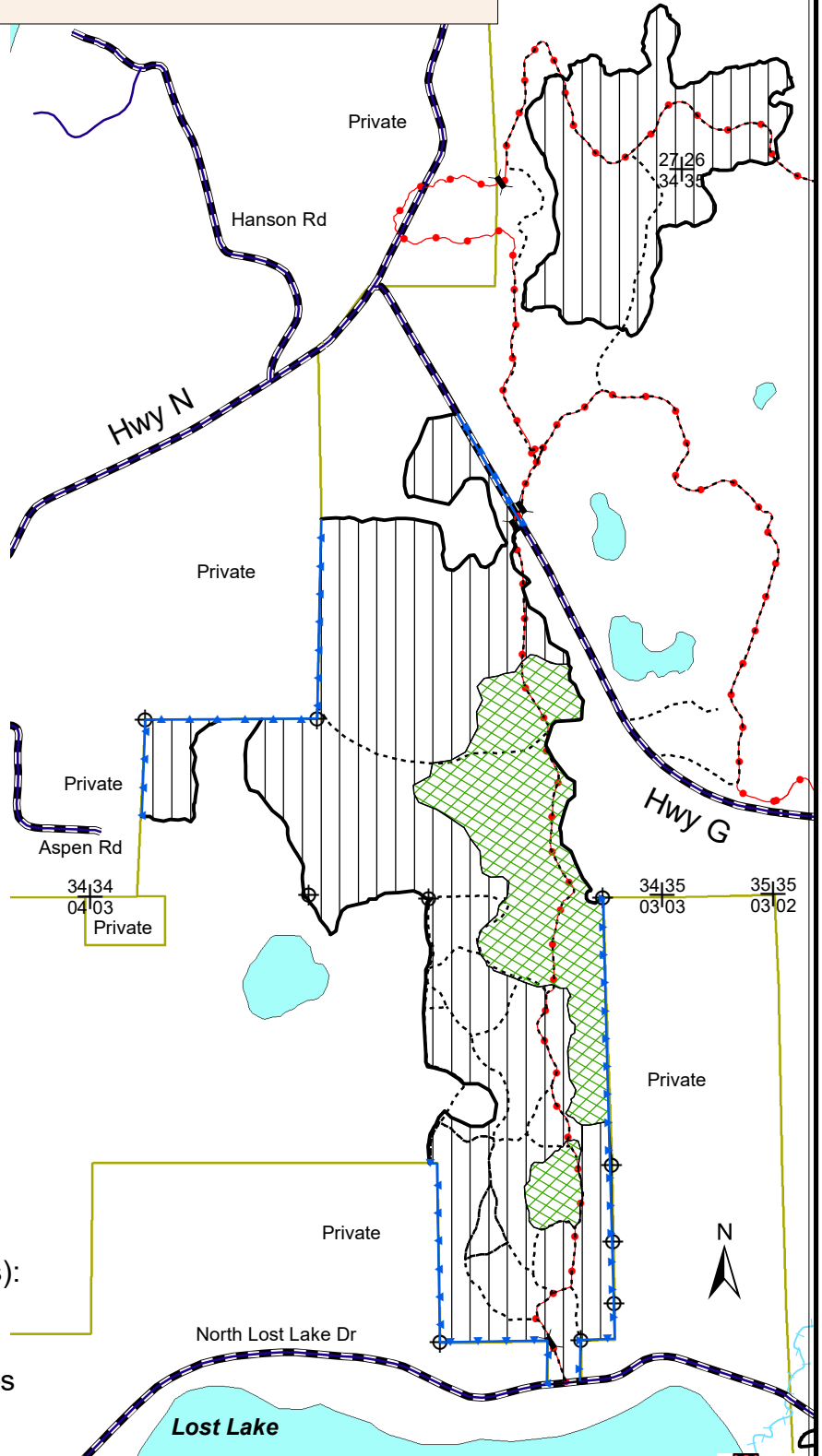
 Hardwood thinning Area (238 Acres):

Vilas County

The cutting area is approximately 292 acres.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to a 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

Whole tree utilization is not allowed.

¹ Approximately 90% balsam fir, 7% white pine, 1% red pine, 1% jack pine, 1% spruce.

² Volume includes 46 MBF of oak.

³ Approximately 58% hard maple, 38% red maple, 2% ironwood, 2% yellow birch. Volume includes 98 MBF of hard maple, 78 MBF of red maple, and 3 MBF of yellow birch.

Note: Total sale volume equates to 16.4 tons/acre or 6.8 cords/acre.

Special Conditions:

1. Harvesting, skidding or road construction is permitted from July 16th to April 14th due to the risk of oak wilt.
2. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
3. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees (except balsam fir).
4. Slash within 50 feet of all roads and trails must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and be pulled back 10' behind the tree line concurrently with cutting.
5. Follow WI BMPs for water quality at all times.
6. The Snowmobile Trails must be kept free of debris, remain snow covered in winter, and always left in good condition for vehicle traffic. The trail shall be signed indicating logging activity if any activity occurs during periods that the snowmobile trail is open.
7. Cutting must be concurrent for all species.
8. All landings and new roads must be approved prior to sale start up.
9. Do not cut any trees marked with red, blue, or purple paint.

Notice: Completion of this form is mandatory. The Department will not recognize your bid unless you complete and submit this form. Personal information collected will be used for program administration and may be provided to requesters as required by Wisconsin's Public Records law [ss. 19.31-19.39, Wis. Stats.].
