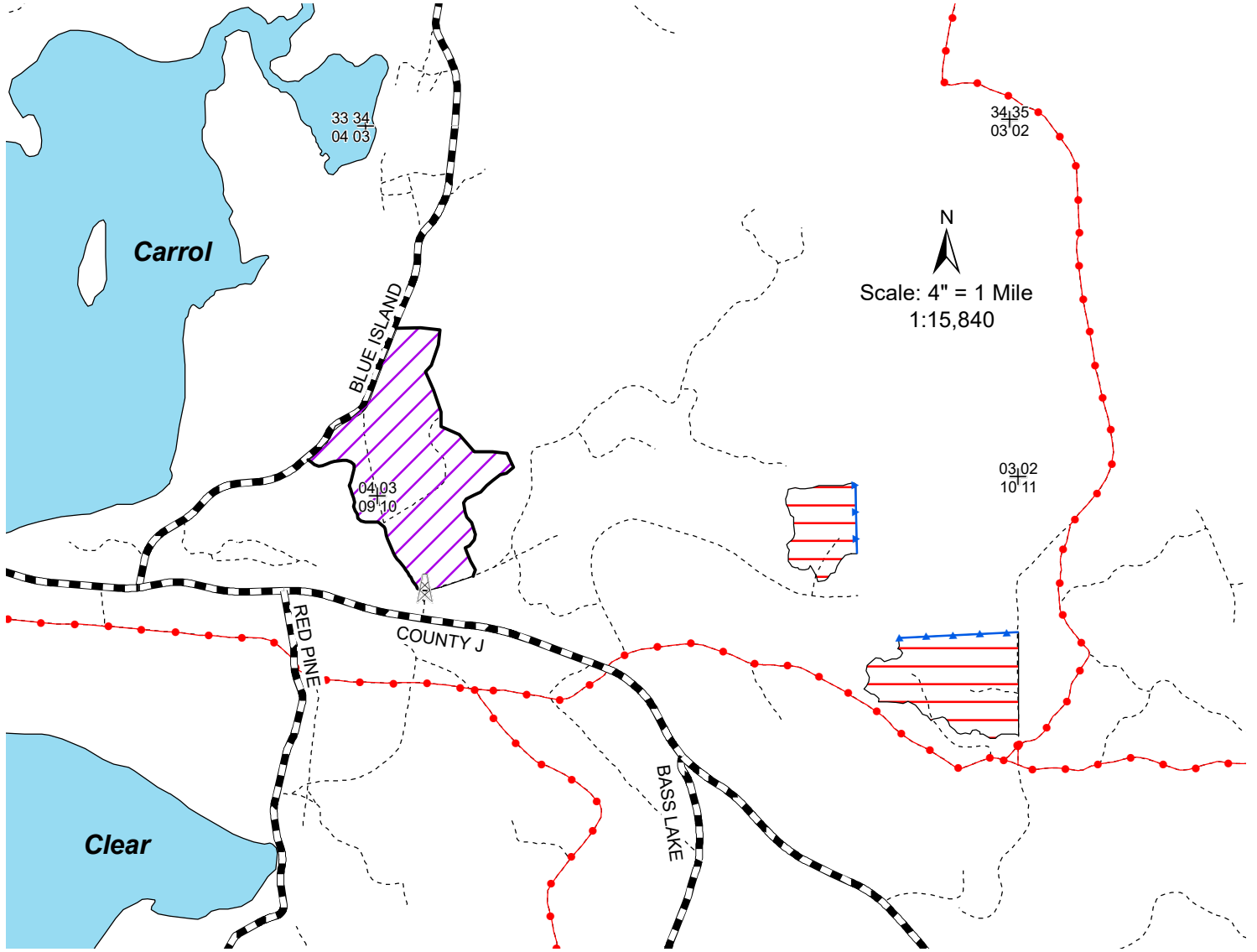

- Hardwood Area (38 Acres): Cut all merchantable ironwood and trees marked with orange paint. Cut all balsam fir > 1" DBH.
- Oak Area (26 Acres): Cut all merchantable maple, ironwood, balsam fir, and trees marked with orange paint.

**Harvesting is allowed July 16th through April 14th.**

<sup>1</sup> Approximately 40% red oak, 33% hard maple, 26% red maple, and 1% ironwood. Includes potential for 33 MBF red oak sawlogs, 12 MBF hard maple sawlogs, and 4 MBF red maple sawlogs.

<sup>2</sup> Approximately 84% balsam fir, 12% white pine, and 4% red pine. Includes potential for 4 MBF white pine sawlogs and 1 MBF red pine sawlogs.

Note: Total sale volume equates to 27.3 tons/acre or 11.2 cords/acre.

Special Conditions:

1. **Seasonal Restriction: Oak Wilt Restriction: Cutting, skidding, or road building is permitted between July 16<sup>th</sup> and April 14<sup>th</sup>.**
2. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
3. Cutting must be concurrent for all species, including 1-5" DBH trees where designated.
4. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees unless they pose a safety hazard.
5. Slash within 50 feet of all roads and trails must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and be pulled back 10 feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting.
