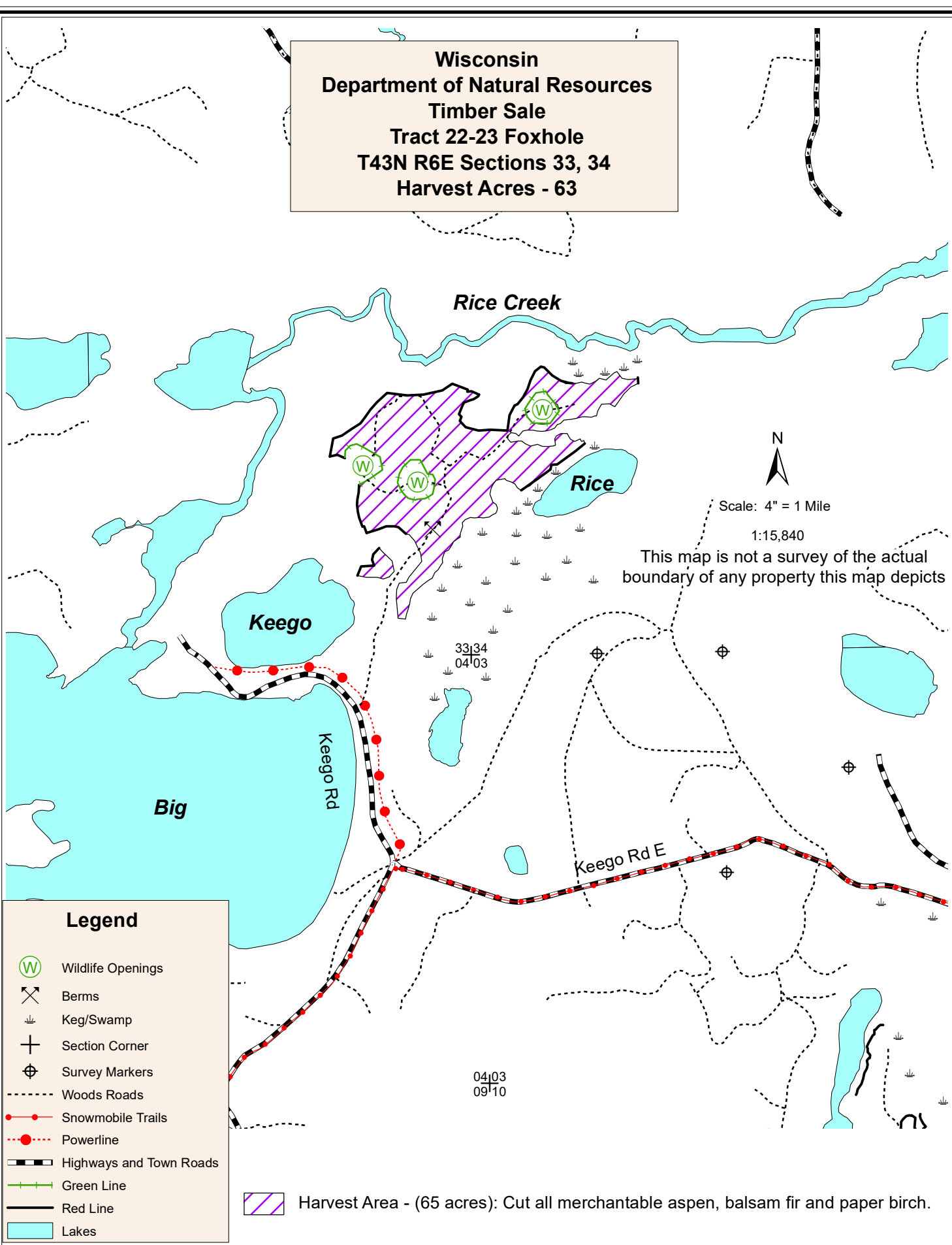

The cutting area is approximately **63 acres**.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

White Birch¹ -- Includes approximately 3 tons of White Birch sawlogs

Note sale volume equates to 40 tons/acre or approximately 19 cords per acre.

Special Conditions:

1. Sale must be harvested on dry or frozen ground only.
2. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
3. Do not cut, knock down, or utilize any dead trees unless they pose an operational safety risk.
4. Biomass harvest and whole tree skidding will not be allowed.
5. All landings and any new roads must be approved prior to sale start up. All roads must be cleared of debris and leveled upon sale completion.
6. Decking or landing of wood in the wildlife openings will not be permitted.
7. Slash must be lopped and scattered to lie within two feet of the ground. No trees shall be felled across any redline, greenline, or into any wetland areas. Trees must be pulled back inside the sale boundary.
8. Follow WI BMP's for water quality at all times. No equipment is allowed within 15 feet of ephemeral ponds or wetlands.
9. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at this time can decide to remedy them before pulling off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.

Notice: Completion of this form is mandatory. The Department will not recognize your bid unless you complete and submit this form. Personal information collected will be used for program administration and may be provided to requesters as required by Wisconsin's Public Records law [ss. 19.31-19.39, Wis. Stats.].

In the event the highest bidder can not or will not sign the contract, the award may be made to the next highest qualified bid.
