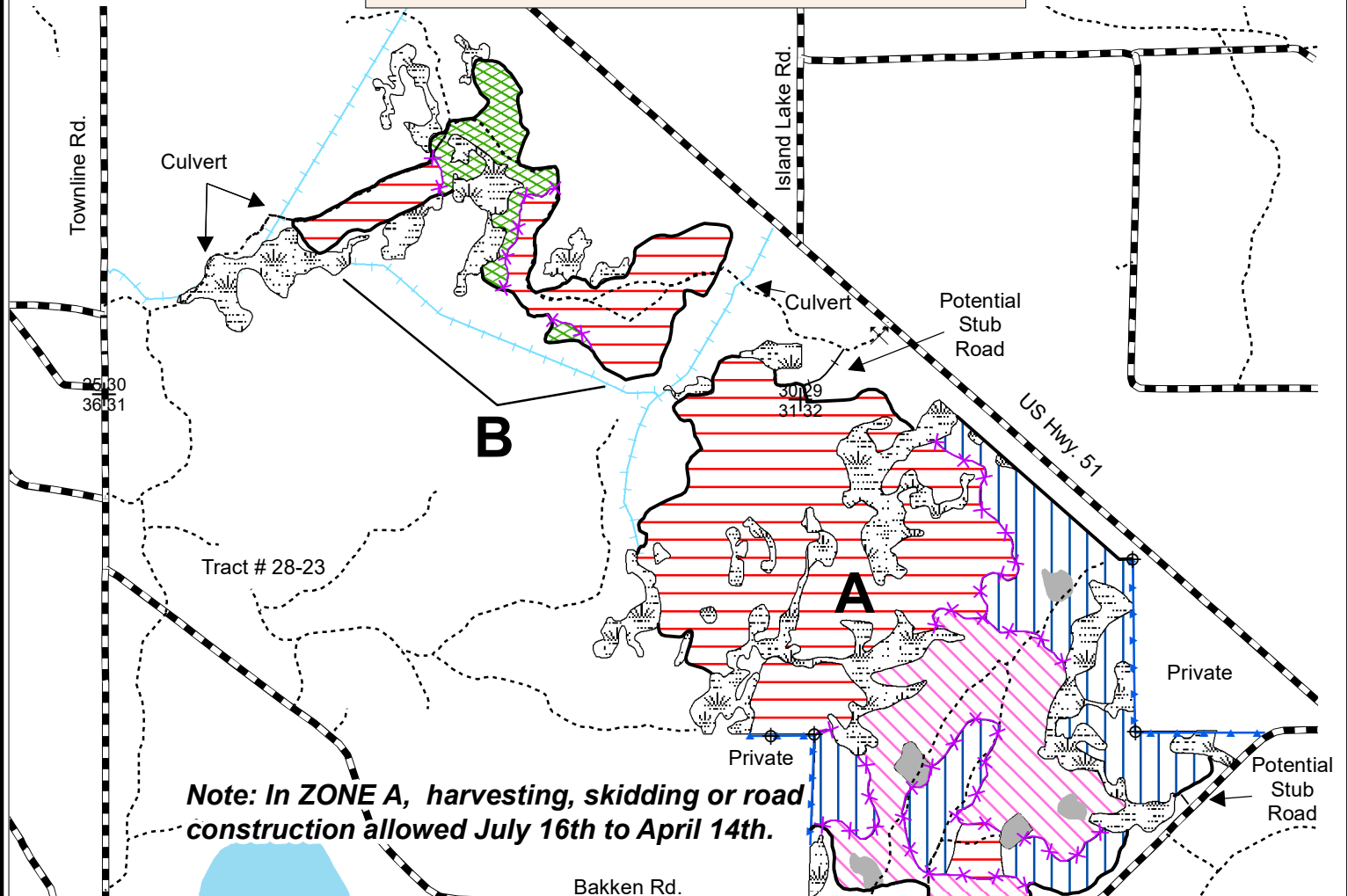

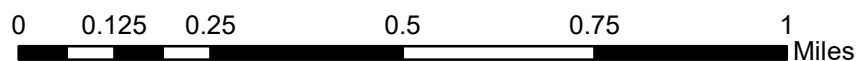


Note: In ZONE A, harvesting, skidding or road construction allowed July 16th to April 14th.

- Aspen Coppice (61 Acres): Cut all aspen, oak, red maple, white birch and cherry larger than 1" DBH as well as orange marked pine.
- Seed Tree (14 Acres): Cut all black spruce, tamarack, white birch and red maple greater than 4" DBH **EXCEPT** trees marked with green paint.
- Pine Thinning (136 Acres): Cut red oak, red maple, white birch, cherry and aspen greater than 6" DBH as well as all orange marked trees.
- Pine Clearcut (53 Acres): Cut all trees larger than 1" DBH **EXCEPT** pine greater than 28" DBH.

Bakken Business

The cutting area is approximately 264 acres.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

Whole tree utilization is allowed.

Sale contains approximately 48.4 tons/acre or approximately 21.6 cords/acre.

Special Conditions:

1. **Seasonal Restriction:** Harvesting, skidding and road construction will only be allowed from July 16th to April 14th in **Zone A**.
2. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
3. All landings and any new roads must be approved prior to sale start up. No decking will be allowed along Bakken Rd without Town approval. All woods roads must be cleared of debris and leveled upon completion of sale.
4. Do not harvest trees or operate equipment with 15 feet of any ephemeral pond. No slash or logging debris shall be deposited within ephemeral ponds.
5. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from the time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
6. Felling and skidding damage to residual trees must be avoided. Do not knock down or utilize any dead trees unless they pose a safety hazard.
7. Slash throughout the of the sale must be evenly scattered and pulled back from town road right of ways. Trees felled across blue paint lines and red paint lines must be pulled back into the sale area prior to processing.
8. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at this time can decide to remedy them before pulling off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.

Notice: Completion of this form is mandatory. The Department will not recognize your bid unless you complete and submit this form. In the event the highest bidder can not or will not sign the contract, the award may be made to the next highest qualified bid.
