### Special Conditions

- 1. SEASONAL RESTRICTION: Harvest activity (cutting and forwarding) is allowed only between August 11 and May 9. Hauling of cut products allowed year round.
- 2. Snowmobile trail must be kept free of debris, snow covered in winter, and always left in good condition for vehicle traffic. All landings and any new roads must be approved prior to sale start up. All roads must be cleared of debris and leveled upon sale completion.
- 3. Do not harvest any trees or operate machinery within 15 feet of any wetland. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
- 4. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
- 5. Biomass harvesting is not allowed. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees unless they pose an operational safety risk.
- 6. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection, provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at that time can decide to remedy them before pulling equipment off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen, documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.
