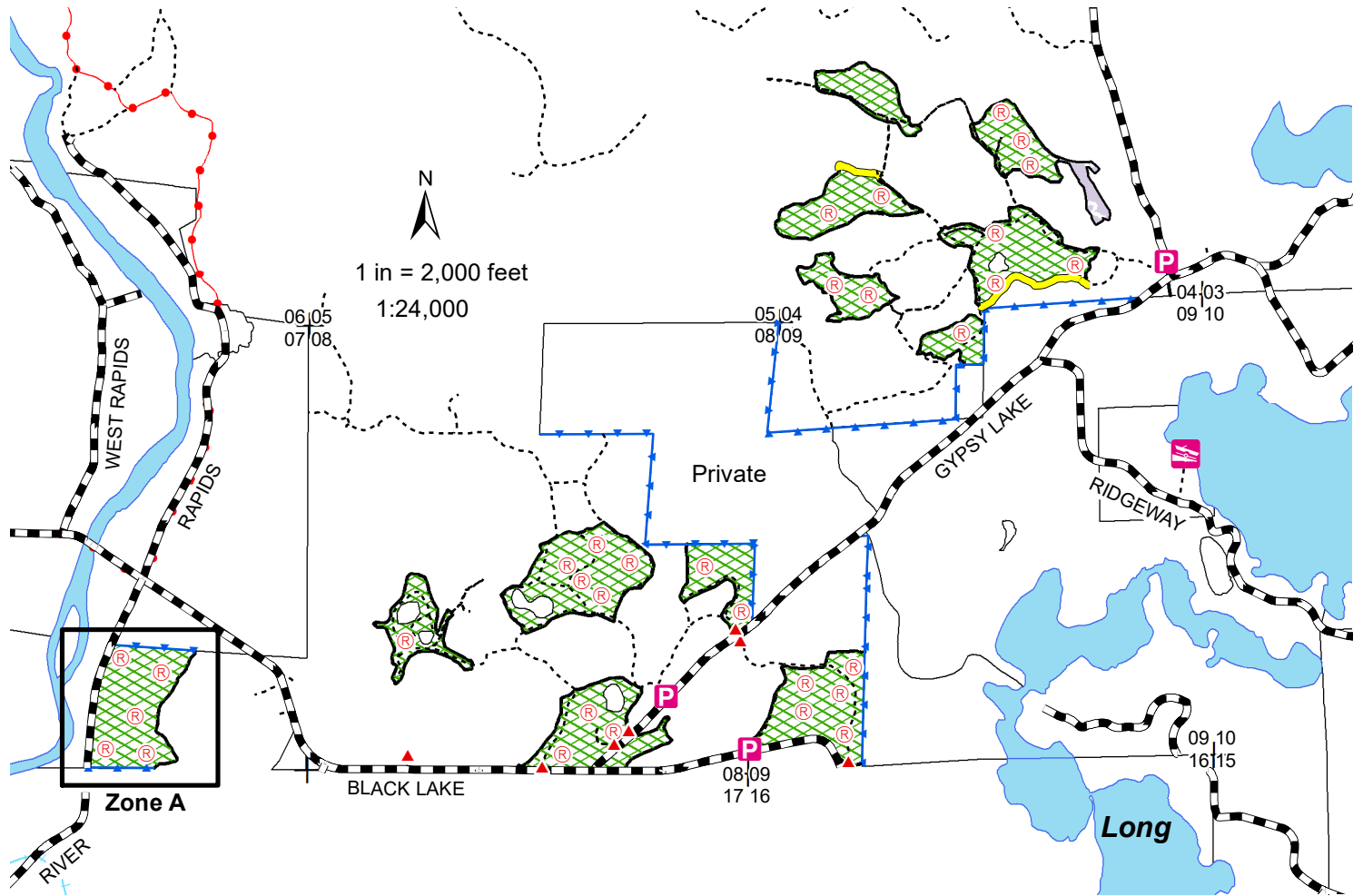

- Harvest Area (203 Acres) cut all aspen, maple, birch and jack pine >1" DBH. Cut all merchantable balsam and trees marked with orange paint. Do not cut trees marked with green paint.
- Trees marked with purple paint are to be cut, leaving a 5' stump above the ground. The bottom 12' of the main bole is to be left on the ground directly adjacent to the stump. Any remaining product can be utilized by the contractor.
- Green Tree Retention Area: Do not harvest in this area.
- Road Construction: Contractor will be required to create driveable woods roads in these sections that connect to the existing road network. Approx 0.4 miles.
- Green Tree Retention Islands: The boundaries of these GTR islands are marked with red paint. Do not harvest any trees within these areas.

**Zone A** Harvesting in this zone is allowed November 1st through March 14th.

**Harvesting is allowed July 16th through April 14th except in Zone A.**

First Flush

The cutting area is approximately 203 acres.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to a minimum top diameter of 4" will be cut and utilized.

Whole tree harvest **is not** allowed.

The total sale volume equates to approximately 59.4 tons/acre or 26.1 cords/acre.

Special Conditions

1. Harvesting and road building are allowed from July 16<sup>th</sup> – April 14<sup>th</sup> except in Zone A where both activities are allowed from November 1<sup>st</sup> – March 14<sup>th</sup>.
2. Do not cut any trees within 15 feet of any ephemeral pond. All other low areas are to be operated in during dry or frozen ground conditions to prevent rutting. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
3. All slash must be pulled back at least 25 feet away from any road or trail.
4. No slash allowed across any blue line, red line, powerline, or within any wetland. Slash must be lopped and scattered to lay within 2 feet of the ground and pulled back into the sale area at least 25 feet away from the adjacent private lands and public roads.
5. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved prior to sale start up.
6. All pine products cut between April 1<sup>st</sup> and September 1<sup>st</sup> must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from the time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.
7. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off site. During the "pull-off" inspection, provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at that time can decide to remedy them before pulling equipment off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen, documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.
8. The contractor will be required to create two sections of drivable woods roads in areas designated on the timber sale map. The road will be required to be 18 feet wide at the roadbed with all stumps removed. Total length of new road construction is approximately 2000 feet.

In the event the highest bidder can not or will not sign the contract, the award may be made to the next highest qualified bid.
