

Special Conditions

- 1. SEASONAL RESTRICTION: Harvesting and hauling is allowed only between December 1 and March 15. Access will be allowed only when Downda Lane is frozen. Downda Lane must be kept level and clear of all debris to allow unhindered access by the private residents.
- 2. Merchantable timber that results from widening the private road will be decked and scaled separately from the State wood. The value of this timber will be paid to the private landowner at a rate as determined between the bidder and the landowner.
- 3. Biomass harvesting is not allowed. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees unless they pose an operational safety risk.
- 4. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection, provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at that time can decide to remedy them before pulling equipment off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen, documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.

^{2\} Contains approximately 250 tons and 40 MBF sugar maple, 40 tons and 8 MBF red maple, 20 tons and 6 MBF basswood and 18 tons white birch.
