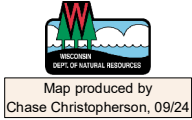

-  Aspen/Pin Oak (24 Acres): Cut all aspen, birch, jack pine, maple, oak and orange marked trees. Cut all aspen, oak and maple 1-5" in diameter.
-  Aspen (121 Acres): Cut all aspen, balsam fir, birch, jack pine and maple. Cut only orange marked pine and oak. Cut all aspen and maple 1-5" in diameter.

Note: Do NOT cut trees marked with green paint.

The cutting area is approximately 175 acres.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter will be cut and utilized. Whole Tree harvest is allowed.

3 Pin Oak consists of 92% pin oak and 8% red oak.

4 Mixed Hardwood consists of 56% red maple and 44% white birch.

Note: Total sale volume equates to 52 tons/ac. or 23 cords/ac. (4" top); 71 tons/ac. or 31 cords/ac. (WT).

Special Conditions:

1. **LUMP SUM SALE:** One-quarter of the total lump sum bid value must be paid prior to starting. The remaining amounts will be paid as each quarter of the sale is completed, with final payment made before the last 1/4 of the acreage is harvested. All trees are to be pre-approved prior to cutting if not marked or designated to be cut. Any residual trees cut, pushed over or damaged are to be decked, scaled and billed in addition to lump sum value. Any trees cut without approval will subject the contractor to penalties and fines.
2. Wisconsin's Forestland Woody Biomass Harvesting Guidelines must be complied with during operations on this timber sale and will be strictly enforced.
3. Snowmobile trails must be kept free of debris and left in good condition for vehicle traffic at all times.
4. Do not cut, knock down, or utilize any dead trees unless they pose a hazard to the contractor.
5. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.

Notice: Completion of this form is mandatory. The Department will not recognize your bid unless you complete and submit this form. Personal information collected will be used for program administration and may be provided to requesters as required by Wisconsin's Public Records law [ss. 19.31-19.39, Wis. Stats.].
