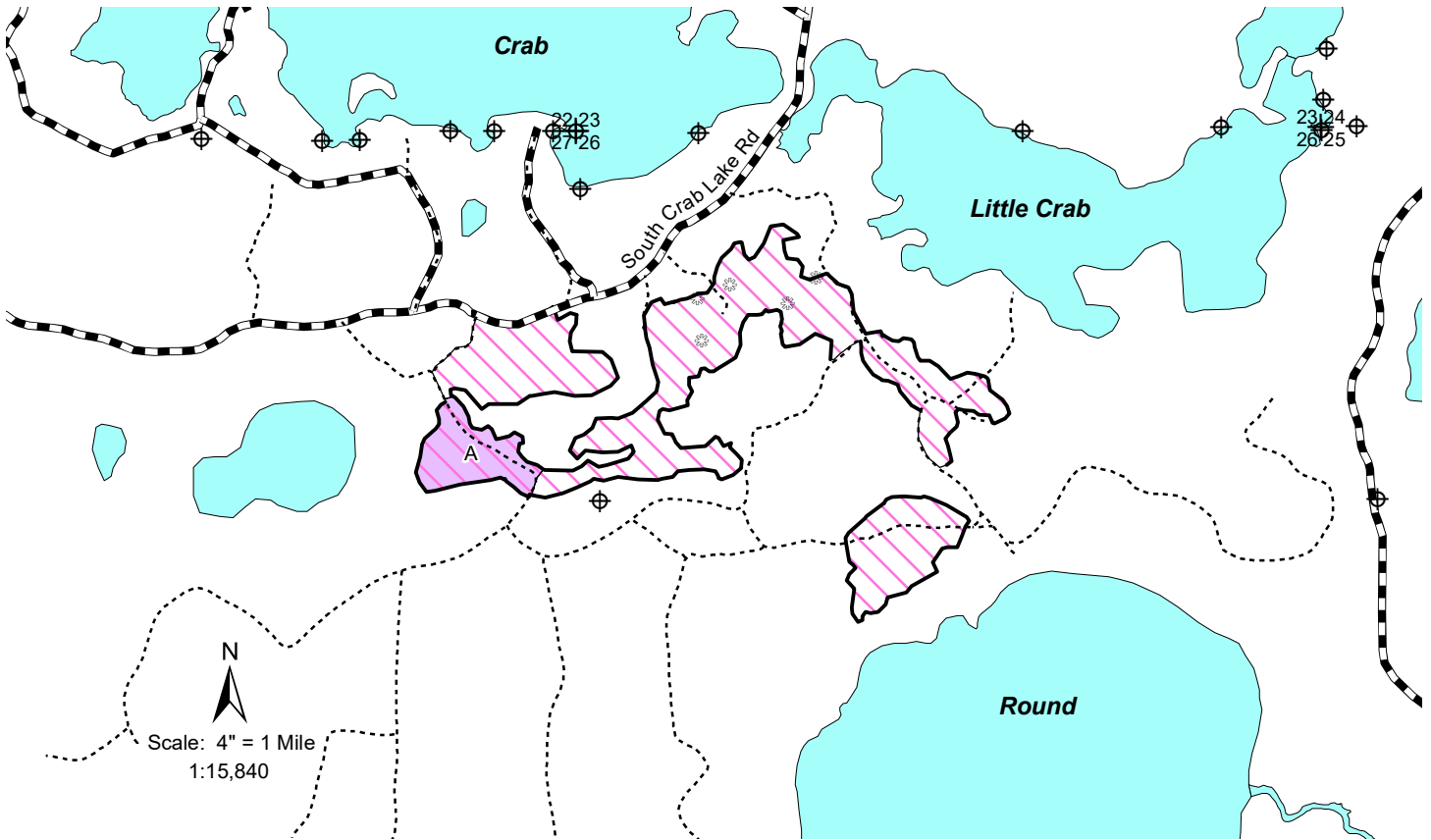










All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to a minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

Whole tree utilization is NOT allowed.

1\ Contains approximately 52% sugar maple, 28% red maple, 15% basswood and 5% ash. Volume includes approximately 34 MBF sugar maple, 33 MBF basswood, 28 MBF red maple, and 8 MBF ash.

2\ Contains approximately 8 MBF red oak.

Sale contains approximately 22 tons/acre or 10 cords/acre.

Special Conditions

1. SEASONAL RESTRICTION: Harvest activity allowed in the area that is shaded and labeled Zone A is allowed only between July 16 thru April 14.
2. All landings and any new roads must be approved prior to sale start up. All roads must be cleared of debris and leveled upon sale completion.
3. Treat all slash within 25 feet of the Town Road to lie within 2 feet of the ground.
4. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees unless they pose an operational safety risk.
5. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection, provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at that time can decide to remedy them before pulling equipment off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen, documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.
