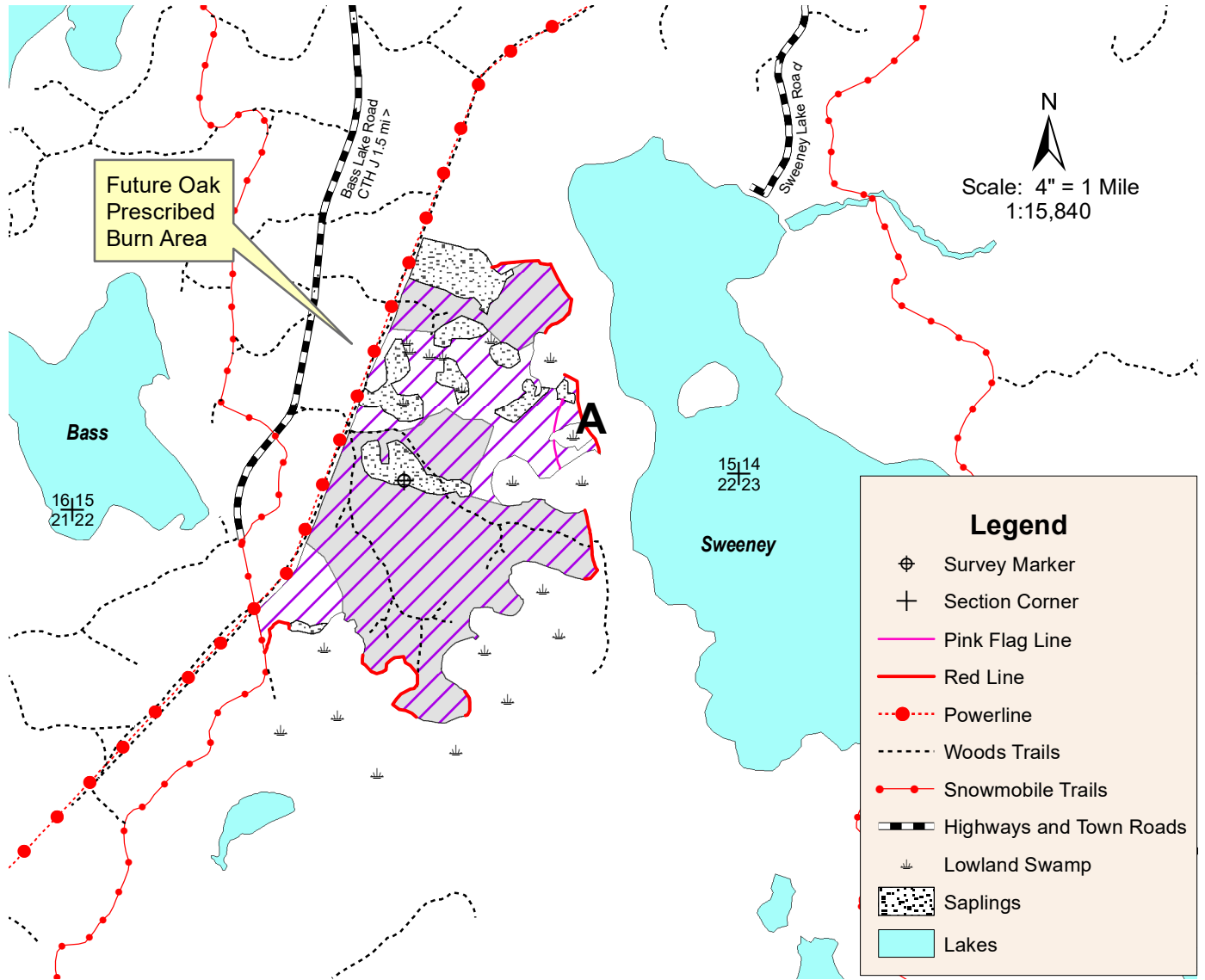

 Main Sale Area (109 Acres): Cut all aspen, with 3 or more sticks. Cut all other trees except spruce and purple marked trees. Cut ONLY red & white pine marked with orange paint. Cut all 1-5 inch stems within the area that is shaded gray on the timber sale map.

Note: Seasonal Restriction: Equipment use is only allowed between July 16 - April 14, in the Main Sale Area. In ZONE A, all equipment use is allowed August 15 - April 14 only.

The cutting area is approximately 109 acres.
All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to a minimum 4” top diameter will be cut and utilized.

¹Volume includes approximately 52% white pine and 48% balsam fir. Volume includes approximately 29 MBF of potential white pine logs.

²Volume includes approximately 31 MBF of potential red pine logs.

³Volume includes approximately 226 MBF of potential red oak logs.

⁴Volume includes approximately 50% sugar maple, 45% red maple, 2% basswood, 2% ironwood and 1% white birch. Volume includes approximately 16 MBF of potential red maple logs and 9 MBF of potential sugar maple logs.

Total sale volume equates to 52.98 tons/acre or 20.96 cords/acre.

Special Conditions:

- SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS:** All logging operations, including road building, are allowed July 16 – April 14. In ZONE A, all equipment use is allowed August 15 – April 14 only. The administering Forester will ribbon the area delineating Zone A, if necessary. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
- Do not harvest or operate machinery within 15 feet of any ephemeral pond. All other low ground areas to be operated in during dry or frozen ground conditions to prevent rutting. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Hand felling and cable logging operations may be required for harvesting steep ridges where other machinery is inadequate.
- Biomass harvesting is not allowed. Do not cut, knock down, or utilize any dead standing snags unless they create a hazard to harvesting operations. If cut, leave snags where they fall. Do not cut any red or purple marked trees.
- No tops or slash allowed across any red line, powerline, wetlands, ephemeral ponds or within adjacent saplings.
- Snowmobile trail must be kept free of debris, snow covered in winter and always left in good condition for vehicle traffic. All trails must be repaired to pre-harvest conditions upon sale completion. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved prior to sale start-up.
- If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract “pull-off” inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the “pull-off” inspection, provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at that time can decide to remedy them before pulling equipment off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen, documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.

Notice: Completion of this form is mandatory. The Department will not recognize your bid unless you complete and submit this form. Personal information collected will be used for program administration and may be provided to requesters as required by Wisconsin's Public Records law [ss. 19.31-19.39, Wis. Stats.].

In the event the highest bidder can not or will not sign the contract, the award may be made to the next highest qualified bid.
