Special Conditions:

- 1. Do not harvest or operate machinery within 15 feet of any ephemeral pond. All other low ground areas to be operated in during dry or frozen ground conditions to prevent rutting. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
- 2. Biomass harvesting is not allowed. Do not cut, knock down, or utilize any dead standing snags unless they create a hazard to harvesting operations. If cut, leave snags where they fall. Do not cut any red or green marked trees. Ignore old, faded paint on trees.
- 3. No tops or slash allowed in the wildlife openings, wetlands, or ephemeral ponds.
- 4. Snowmobile trail must be kept free of debris, snow covered in winter and always left in good condition for vehicle traffic. All trails must be repaired to pre-harvest conditions upon sale completion. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved prior to sale start-up.
- 5. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
- 6. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection, provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at that time can decide to remedy them before pulling equipment off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen, documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.
