## **Special Conditions:**

- 1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
- 2. All landings and any new roads must be approved prior to sale start up. No decking will be allowed along Dairymens Rd or Wildcat Rd without Town approval. All woods roads must be cleared of debris and leveled upon completion of sale.
- 3. The snowmobile trail must be kept free of debris, snow covered in winter and always left in good condition for vehicle traffic. The trail must be repaired to pre-harvest condition prior to each snow season. Slash within 50 feet of the snowmobile trail and Town roads must be lopped and scattered to within two feet of the ground and pulled back into the sale at least 50 feet.
- 4. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from the time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
- 5. Felling and skidding damage to residual trees must be avoided. Do not knock down or utilize any dead trees unless they pose a safety hazard. Trees felled across blue paint lines and red paint lines must be pulled back into the sale area prior to processing.
- 6. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at this time can decide to remedy them before pulling off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.
