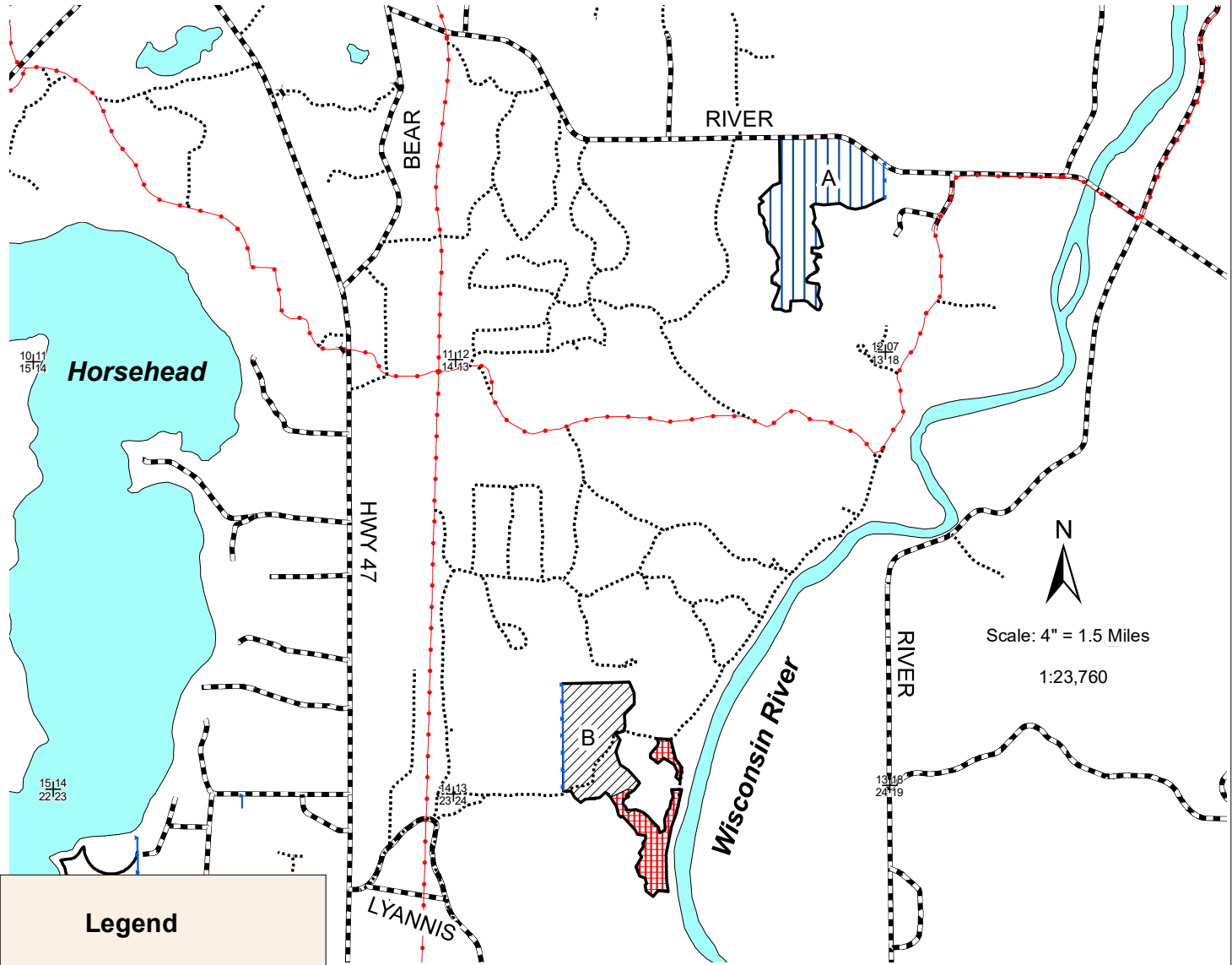

- Overstory Removal (11 acres): Cut all merchantable trees except white pine. Harvest allowed October 16 - April 14.

South River

The cutting area is approximately 74 acres.

All other trees that yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

Special Conditions:

- 1. Coppice Area A- Northern Aspen** Seasonal restriction: Harvest activity allowed July 16 - April 14
- 2. Coppice Area B- Southern Aspen and Overstory Removal- Oak** Seasonal restriction: Harvest activity allowed October 16-April 14
3. Do not cut, knock down or utilize dead trees unless they are a safety hazard.
4. Slash within 50 feet of all roads, trails, private land, and waterbodies must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and be pulled back 10 feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting. No slash allowed across any blue line, or within any wetland or waterbody.
5. Follow WI BMP's for water quality at all times.
6. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Do not damage residual trees.
7. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved by the timber sale administrator.
8. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off site. During the "pull-off" inspection, provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at that time can decide to remedy them before pulling equipment off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen, documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.
9. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
10. Access to the south units of the timber sale may require hauling on and or crossing a snowmobile trail. If hauling during snowmobile season, the trail shall be signed to make users aware of the logging activity.

I also understand that if I am awarded the contract and fail to execute it or work under it, I will be required to forfeit to the Department an amount equal to 10% of my total bid amount.** Failure to forfeit the 10% penalty will result in being considered ineligible to bid on any state timber sales for a two-year duration. In the event the highest bidder can not or will not sign the contract, the award may be made to the next highest qualified bid.
