

C155H Stand #3 (131 acres) - Red pine 1918 origin. Last thinned in 2003.

C155H Stand #9 (81 acres) - Red Pine 1915 origin. Last thinned in 1996.

Stands 3 and 9 will be thinned to promote growth and vigor on the red pine. Both stands have multiple, large red pine pocket decline areas. Pockets will be harvested to salvage loss of anticipated merchantable volume and increase stand diversity by releasing advanced regeneration. A field visit with the forest health specialist is scheduled to discuss additional management options.

C155H Stand #7 (78 acres) - Aspen 1971 origin with a scrub oak secondary type. The prescription will be coppice with standards.

C155H Stand #10 (38 acres) - Oak, birch, aspen, pine mix lakeshore aesthetic zone with no known history of forest management. The stand will be thinned and scattered overmature trees harvested.

Stands 7 and 10 will be managed with visual aesthetics in mind by dividing the stands into sections and only harvesting portions now.

C155H Stand #14 (8 acres) - Red pine 1986 origin. First thinning of the pines to promote growth and vigor in the stand.
