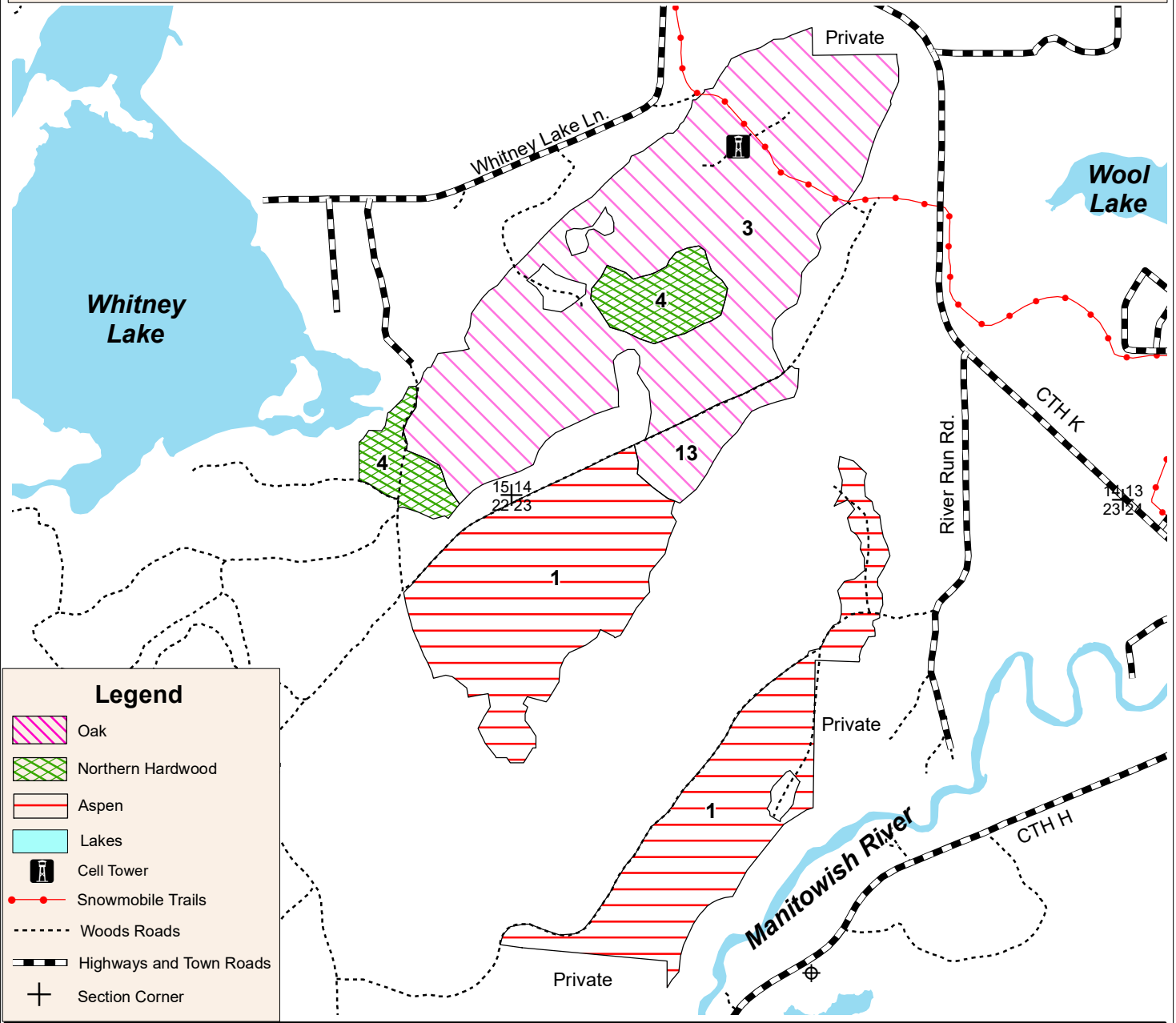


**Northern Highland - American Legion State Forest**

C176 Stand 3 (159 Acres) Is 108 year old large sawtimber red oak stand that is fully stocked with advanced regeneration. This stand will now receive an overstory removal to promote the growth of oak and mixed hardwood regeneration.

C176 Stand 4 (24 Acres) Is a northern hardwood stand with secondary components of oak and hemlock. This stand will be thinned following the standard order of removal to promote health and vigor of the residual stand. A portion of this stand may be scarified to encourage hemlock regeneration.

C177 Stand 1 (138 Acres) Is a 48 year old aspen stand that will be regenerated using a coppice with standards. This stand was originally 359 acres and is being split into 3 separate stands to increase aspen age class diversity and structure.

C177 Stand 13 (13 Acres) Is 110 year old large sawtimber red oak stand that is fully stocked with advanced regeneration. This stand will now receive an overstory removal to promote the growth of oak and mixed hardwood regeneration.
