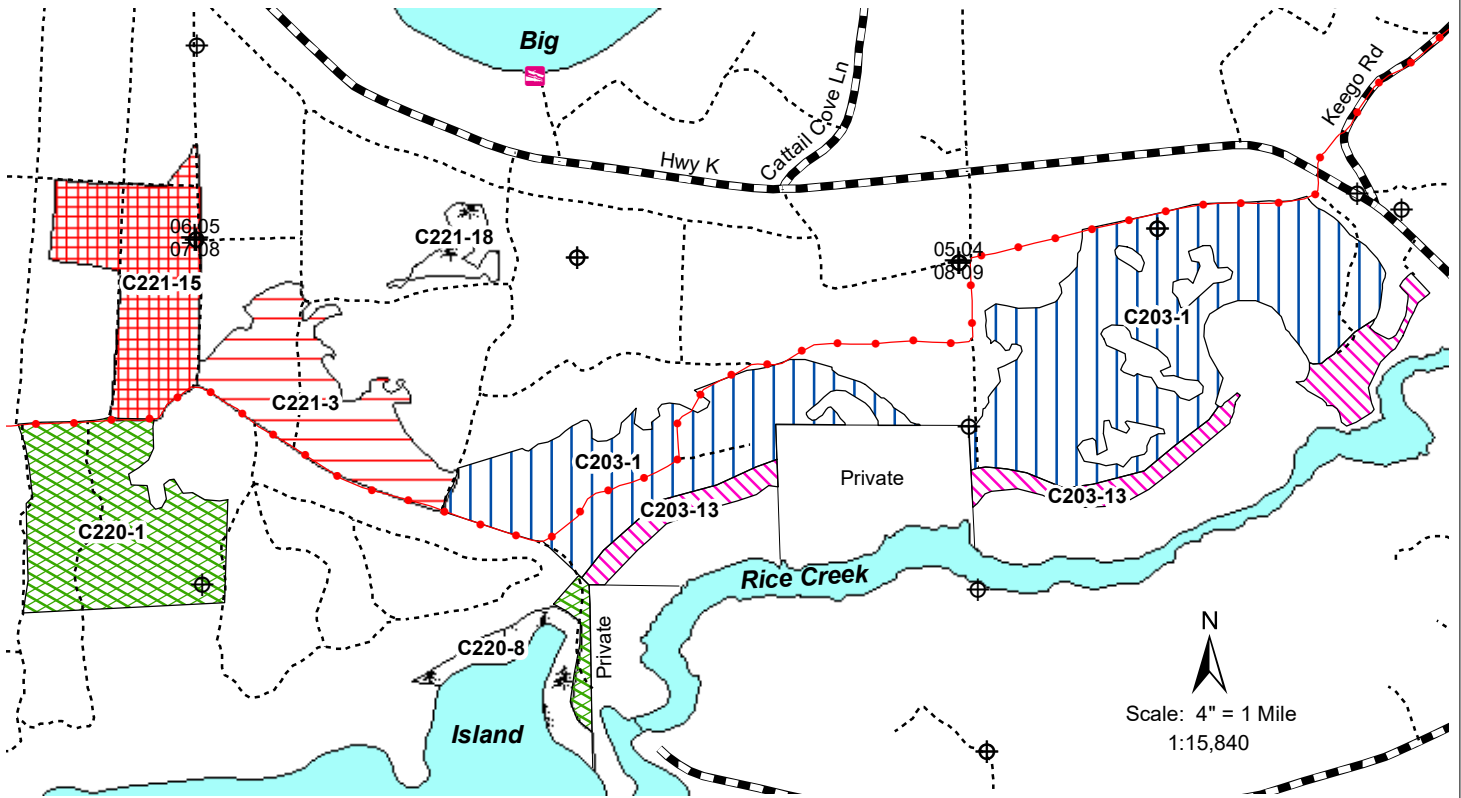

C203H Stand #1 (106 acres) - Aspen origin 1967. Prescription will be coppice with standards to regenerate the aspen.

C203H Stand #13 (18 acres) - This stand is typed as white birch origin 1923. Much of the stand is on a steep hillside along the rice creek marshy area and inaccessible. Early successional trees that can be reached will be harvested.

C220 Stand #1 (37 acres) Stand #1 is a 178 acre aspen stand of 1975 origin. The portion shown on the map is predominantly mature jack pine with scattered poor quality aspen. The objective is to clearcut this area and plant it to pine.

C220 Stand #8 (8 acres) - Aspen stand along lakeshore listed as 1920 origin. This part of the stand shown on the map has dense areas of pine that will be thinned and the overmature aspen harvested.

C221H Stand #3 (27 acres) - Aspen origin 1970. Prescription will be coppice with standards to regenerate the aspen.

C221H Stand #15 (27 acres) - Red pine origin 1994. First thinning of the pines to promote growth and vigor in the stand.

C221H Stand #18 (4 acres) - Black spruce. Will evaluate for management.

Biomass harvest is allowed for the much of the presale area.
