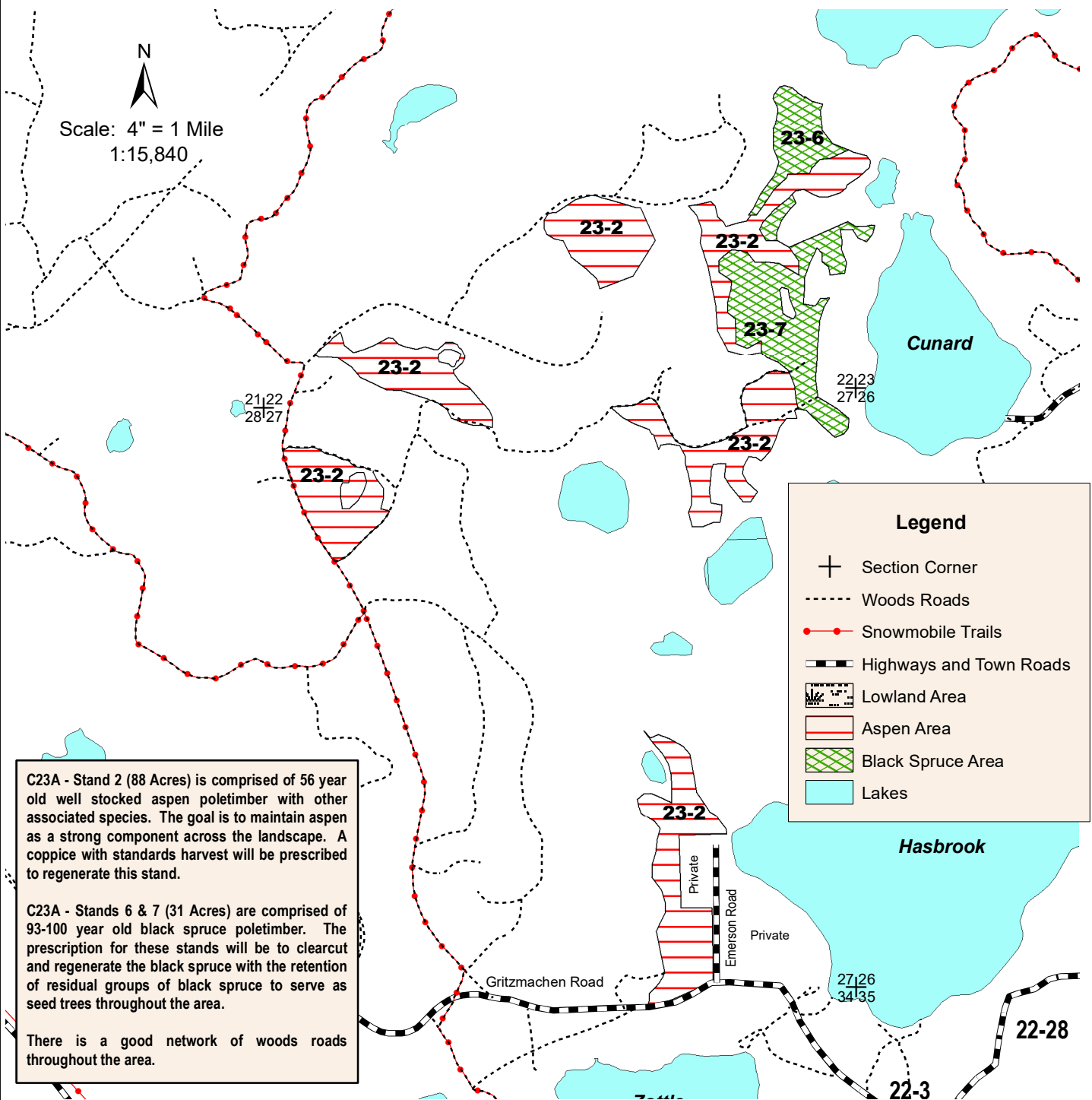


**Northern Highland - American Legion State Forest**

C23A - Stand 2 (88 Acres) is comprised of 56 year old well stocked aspen poletimber with other associated species. The goal is to maintain aspen as a strong component across the landscape. A coppice with standards harvest will be prescribed to regenerate this stand.

C23A - Stands 6 & 7 (31 Acres) are comprised of 93-100 year old black spruce poletimber. The prescription for these stands will be to clearcut and regenerate the black spruce with the retention of residual groups of black spruce to serve as seed trees throughout the area.

There is a good network of woods roads throughout the area.
