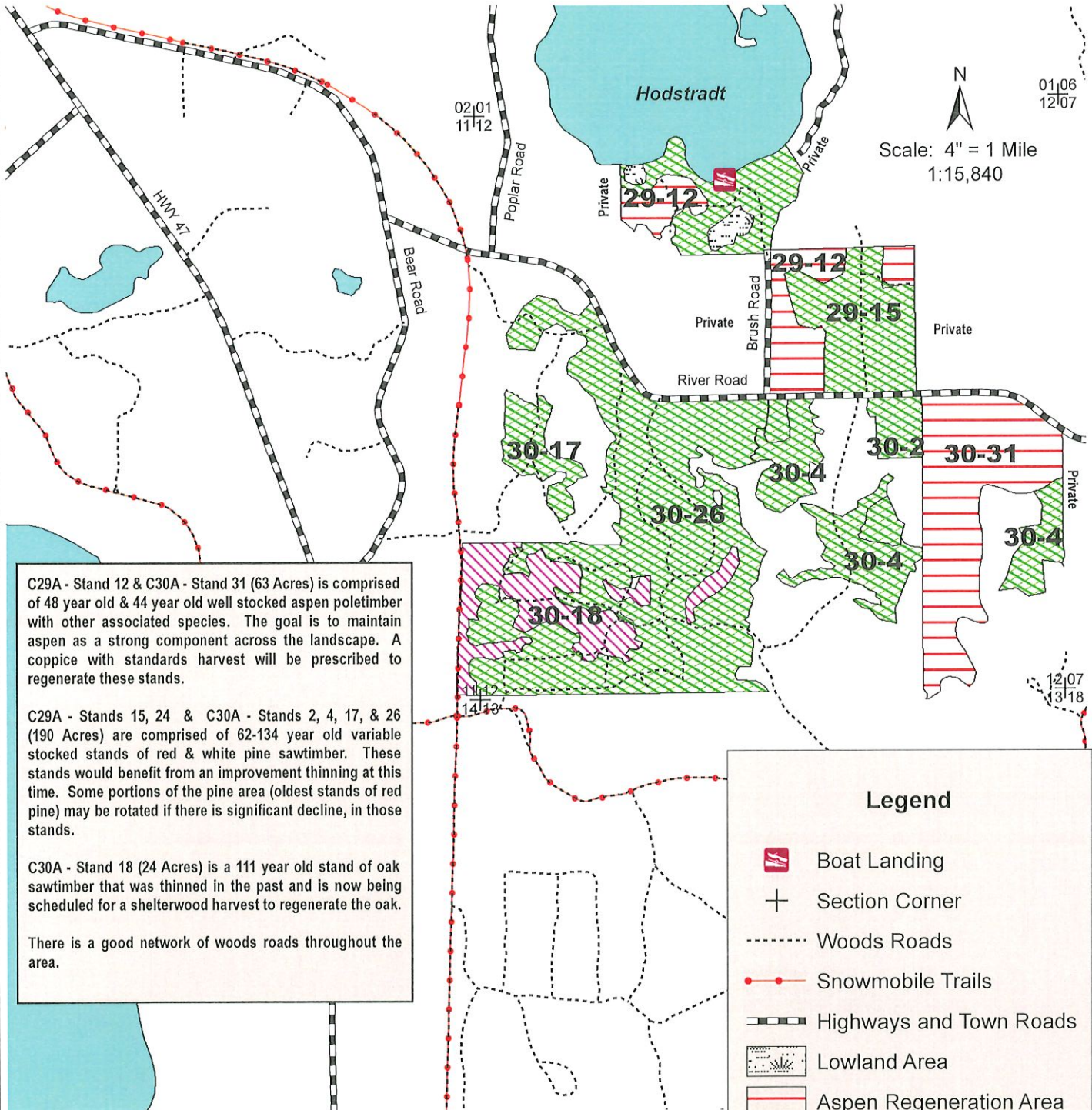


**Northern Highland - American Legion State Forest**

**Hoddie Pine & Popple 277 Acres**

C29A - Stand 12 & C30A - Stand 31 (63 Acres) is comprised of 48 year old & 44 year old well stocked aspen poletimber with other associated species. The goal is to maintain aspen as a strong component across the landscape. A coppice with standards harvest will be prescribed to regenerate these stands.

C29A - Stands 15, 24 & C30A - Stands 2, 4, 17, & 26 (190 Acres) are comprised of 62-134 year old variable stocked stands of red & white pine sawtimber. These stands would benefit from an improvement thinning at this time. Some portions of the pine area (oldest stands of red pine) may be rotated if there is significant decline, in those stands.

C30A - Stand 18 (24 Acres) is a 111 year old stand of oak sawtimber that was thinned in the past and is now being scheduled for a shelterwood harvest to regenerate the oak.

There is a good network of woods roads throughout the area.
