PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO REISSUE A WISCONSIN POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (WPDES) PERMIT No.WI-0020214-11-0

Permittee: Village of Cochrane, Village Hall, Cochrane, WI, 54622-0222

Facility Where Discharge Occurs: Village of Cochrane, 311 Michaels St, Cochrane, WI 54622

Receiving Water And Location: the groundwater of the Trempealeau River Drainage Basin in Buffalo County

Brief Facility Description and Summary of Proposed Changes: The Cochrane Wastewater Treatment Facility treats domestic wastewater from the Village of Cochrane and Pleasant Valley Mobile Home Park. The facility has an annual average design flow of 0.0722 million gallons per day (MGD) and an actual average discharge flow of 0.0311 MGD in 2022. The treatment system is operated on a seasonal basis (fill and draw) and consists of two stabilization ponds and two seepage cells. A groundwater monitoring system exists onsite to monitor any possible groundwater impact from the effluent discharged to the seepage cells. Significant monitoring and/or limit changes proposed in the upcoming permit term are as follows: 1) the alternate concentration limit (ACL) for nitrite + nitrate nitrogen decreased, 2) the preventative action limit (PAL) for total dissolved solids decreased, 3) the PAL range for pH increased, 4) influent total nitrogen monitoring has been added, and 5) the influent flow sample frequency has been changed from "continuous" to "daily". Clarification language has been added notifying the permittee they must monitor sludge for List 2 nutrients and meet the requirements of List 3 (Pathogen Control) and List 4 (Vector Attraction Reduction) prior to landspreading if they remove sludge from the lagoon(s). Additionally, to quantitate the risk, PFAS sludge sampling has been included in the permit pursuant to ss. NR 214.18(5)(b) and NR 204.06(2)(b)9., Wis. Adm. Code. A schedule has been included requiring the permittee submit a sludge management plan prior to removal and land application of sludge from the pond(s). A schedule has also been included that requires submittal of updated Land Treatment Management plan.

The Department has tentatively decided that the above-specified WPDES permit should be reissued.

Limitations and conditions which the Department believes adequately protect the receiving water are included in the proposed permit. Land application of waste shall be done in accordance with permit conditions and applicable codes. All land application sites shall be approved prior to their use. To receive a list of approved sites, or to be notified of potential approvals, contact the above-named basin engineer.

Persons wishing to comment on or object to the proposed permit action, or to request a public hearing, may write to the Department of Natural Resources at the above-named permit drafter's address. All comments or suggestions received no later than 30 days after the publication date of this public notice will be considered along with other information on file in making a final decision regarding the permit. Anyone providing comments in response to this public notice will receive a notification of the Department's final decision when the permit is issued. Where designated as a reviewable surface water discharge permit, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is allowed up to 90 days to submit comments or objections regarding this permit determination. If no comments are received on the proposed permit from anyone, including U.S. EPA, the permit will be issued as proposed.

The Department may schedule a public informational hearing if requested by any person and shall schedule a public informational hearing if a petition requesting a hearing is received from 5 or more persons or if response to this notice indicates significant public interest pursuant to s. 283.49, Wis. Stats. Requests for a public informational hearing shall state the following: the name and address of the person(s) requesting the hearing; the interest in the proposed permit of the person(s) requesting the hearing; the reasons for the request; and the issues proposed to be considered at the hearing.

Information on file for this permit action, including the draft permit, fact sheet and permit application, may be inspected and copied at either the above-named permit drafter's office or the above named basin engineer's office, Monday through Friday (except holidays), between 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Please call the permit drafter or basin engineer for directions to their office location, if necessary. Information on this permit action may also be obtained by calling the permit drafter at (715) 492-0483 or by writing to the Department. Reasonable costs (15 cents per page for copies and 7 cents per page for scanning) will be charged for information in the file other than the public notice, permit and fact sheet.
